inconceivable	Not capable of being imagined or grasped mentally; unbelievable. <i>It seemed inconceivable that the president had been unaware of what was going on.</i>
incredible	Impossible to believe. <i>The book s plot is simply incredible.</i>

incredibly	Not easy to believe. <i>Incredibly she survived the crash.</i>
marvelous	Being or having the character of a miracle. <i>A marvelous collection of rare books.</i>
miraculously	In a remarkable and extremely lucky manner. <i>A shrine where people bring the sick to be miraculously healed.</i>
practically	For all practical purposes but not completely. <i>Practically everything in Hinduism is the manifestation of a god.</i>
profound	Profound quality. <i>Profound contempt.</i>
redoubtable	(of a person) formidable, especially as an opponent. <i>He was a redoubtable debater.</i>
serendipity	The occurrence and development of events by chance in a happy or beneficial way. <i>A fortunate stroke of serendipity.</i>
shattering	The act of breaking something into small pieces. <i>The shattering tones of the enormous carillon.</i>
staggering	So surprisingly impressive as to stun or overwhelm. <i>Suffered a staggering defeat.</i>
startling	So remarkably different or sudden as to cause momentary shock or alarm. <i>Sydney's startling new Opera House.</i>
surprisingly	In an amazing manner; to everyone's surprise. <i>The move was surprisingly easy.</i>
unbelievable	So great or extreme as to be difficult to believe; extraordinary. <i>Your audacity is unbelievable.</i>
unbelievably	To a great degree; extremely. <i>Unbelievably all this is yours for 50p.</i>
unexpected	Not expected or regarded as likely to happen. <i>Unexpected guests.</i>
unexpectedly	Without advance planning. <i>He died unexpectedly of a heart attack.</i>
unimaginable	Totally unlikely. <i>Lives of almost unimaginable deprivation.</i>
unthinkable	(of a situation or event) too unlikely or undesirable to be considered a possibility. <i>The unthinkable happened I spoke up.</i>
