- Perhaps surprisingly, all survived.

impress Produce or try to produce a vivid impression of.

His desire to put his own **impress** on the films he made.

Totally unlikely.

inconceivable It seemed **inconceivable** that the president had been unaware of what was

going on.

incredible Very good; wonderful.

An almost **incredible** tale of triumph and tragedy.

To a great degree; extremely.

incredibly Michele was incredibly brave.



marvelous

Too improbable to admit of belief.

A marvelous collection of rare books.

miraculously In a remarkable and extremely lucky manner.

The two drivers **miraculously** escaped with only minor injuries.

paradoxically In a seemingly absurd or self-contradictory way.

The strength of capitalism is **paradoxically** also its weakness.

prodigiousRemarkably or impressively great in extent, size, or degree.

A **prodigious** storm.

profound Profound quality.

A profound silence.

staggering So surprisingly impressive as to stun or overwhelm.

The **staggering** bills for maintenance and repair.

Very surprising, astonishing, or remarkable.

startling Startling news.

Surprising Causing surprise or wonder or amazement.

Leaped up with **surprising** agility.

unbelievable So great or extreme as to be difficult to believe; extraordinary.

Unbelievable or not it happened.

unexpected Not expected or regarded as likely to happen.

His death was totally **unexpected**.

unexpectedly Without advance planning.

He died **unexpectedly** of a heart attack.

unusually To a remarkable degree or extent.

The name is spelt **unusually**.

wonderful Inspiring delight, pleasure, or admiration; extremely good; marvellous.

They all think she s **wonderful**.
