Suspicion in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I suspicion We suspicion
You suspicion You suspicion
He/She/It suspicions They suspicion

Suspicion in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am suspicioning We are suspicioning
You are suspicioning You are suspicioning
He/She/It is suspicioning They are suspicioning

Suspicion in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have suspicioned We have suspicioned You have suspicioned You have suspicioned He/She/It has suspicioned They have suspicioned

Suspicion in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been suspicioning
You have been suspicioning
He/She/It has been suspicioning
They have been suspicioning

Suspicion in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **suspicioned** We **suspicioned** You **suspicioned** He/She/It **suspicioned** They **suspicioned**

Suspicion in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was suspicioning We were suspicioning
You were suspicioning
He/She/It was suspicioning They were suspicioning

Suspicion in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had suspicioned We had suspicioned You had suspicioned He/She/It had suspicioned They had suspicioned

Suspicion in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been suspicioning
You had been suspicioning
He/She/It had been suspicioning
They had been suspicioning

Suspicion in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will suspicion We will suspicion
You will suspicion You will suspicion
He/She/It will suspicion They will suspicion

Suspicion in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be suspicioning
You will be suspicioning
He/She/It will be suspicioning
They will be suspicioning

Suspicion in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have suspicioned We will have suspicioned You will have suspicioned He/She/It will have suspicioned They will have suspicioned

Suspicion in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been suspicioning
You will have been suspicioning
He/She/It will have been suspicioning
They will have been suspicioning
