## Associations of "Swamped" (30 Words)

arroyo	A steep-sided gully formed by the action of fast-flowing water in an arid or semi-arid region, found chiefly in the south-western US.
<u>bog</u>	An area of wet muddy ground that is too soft to support a heavy body. The island is a wilderness of <b>bog</b> and loch.
<u>canyon</u>	A deep gorge, typically one with a river flowing through it, as found in North America. <i>The Grand Canyon</i> .
cypress	A cypress tree or branches from it as a symbol of mourning.
<u>damp</u>	Damp air or atmosphere. A <b>damp</b> ed suspension that isolates the chassis from external vibration.
dampness	The state or condition of being slightly wet. The <b>dampness</b> in the air.
dank	Unpleasantly cool and humid. A <b>dank</b> cellar.
floodplain	A low plain adjacent to a river that is formed chiefly of river sediment and is subject to flooding.
forest	Establish a forest on previously unforested land. A large tract of <b>forest</b> .
<u>humid</u>	Marked by a relatively high level of water vapour in the atmosphere. <i>A hot and <b>humid</b> day.</i>
impassable	Impossible to travel along or over. The narrow channels are <b>impassable</b> to ocean going ships.
jungle	A place where hoboes camp. It s a <b>jungle</b> out there.
mangrove	A tidal swamp which is dominated by mangroves.
<u>marsh</u>	New Zealand writer of detective stories (1899-1982. Patches of <b>marsh</b> .



marshland	Land consisting of marshes. <i>Marshland</i> landscapes.
marshy	Characteristic of or resembling a marsh; waterlogged. The <b>marshy</b> ground towards the sea.
mire	Soil with mud muck or mire. The roads retained their winter <b>mire</b> .
morass	A soft wet area of low-lying land that sinks underfoot. In midwinter the track beneath this bridge became a muddy <b>morass</b> .
mud	Plaster with mud. The two sides took over the local media to throw <b>mud</b> at each other.
muddy	Cause to become muddy. The original colours were blurred into <b>muddy</b> pink and yellow.
<u>quagmire</u>	A soft wet area of low-lying land that sinks underfoot. Torrential rain turned the building site into a <b>quagmire</b> .
quicksand	Loose wet sand that yields easily to pressure and sucks in anything resting on or falling into it. John found himself sinking fast in financial <b>quicksand</b> .
riparian	Relating to wetlands adjacent to rivers and streams. The ranch s most expansive <b>riparian</b> habitat.
shoal	Of fish form shoals. These fish can safely be released to <b>shoal</b> with most adult species.
slough	A swamp. The economic <b>slough</b> of the interwar years.
soggy	Having the consistency of dough because of insufficient leavening or improper cooking. The chorus sing powerfully but the interpretation is ultimately <b>soggy</b> .
splashing	The act of splashing a liquid substance on a surface.
swampy	(of soil) soft and watery. A <b>swampy</b> area.
<u>wet</u>	Make one s bed or clothes wet by urinating. A <b>wet</b> windy evening.
wetland	A low area where the land is saturated with water. <i>Wetland</i> habitats.
