Synonyms of "Sweaty" as an adjective (9 Words)

- clammy** Unpleasantly cool and humid.
*The **clammy** atmosphere of the cave.*
- damp** Slightly wet.
*Her hair was still **damp** from the shower.*
- drenched** Abundantly covered or supplied with; often used in combination.
*Moon **drenched** meadows.*
- dripping** Very wet.
***Dripping** wet hair.*
- glowing** Highly enthusiastic.
***Glowing** praise.*
- moist** Marked by a fluid discharge.
*A **moist** breeze.*
- slimy** Covered with or resembling slime.
*A **slimy** cigar puffing political fixer.*
- soggy** Slow and apathetic.
*We squelched through the **soggy** ground.*
- sticky** Having the sticky properties of an adhesive.
*The relationship is going through a **sticky** patch.*
