Synonyms of "Sweaty" as an adjective (9 Words)

clammy	Unpleasantly cool and humid. <i>The clammy atmosphere of the cave.</i>
<u>damp</u>	Slightly wet. <i>Her hair was still damp from the shower.</i>
<u>drenched</u>	Abundantly covered or supplied with; often used in combination. <i>Moon drenched meadows.</i>
<u>dripping</u>	Very wet. <i>Dripping wet hair.</i>
<u>glowing</u>	Highly enthusiastic. <i>Glowing praise.</i>
<u>moist</u>	Marked by a fluid discharge. <i>A moist breeze.</i>
<u>slimy</u>	Covered with or resembling slime. <i>A slimy cigar puffing political fixer.</i>
soggy	Slow and apathetic. <i>We squelched through the soggy ground.</i>
<u>sticky</u>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i>The relationship is going through a sticky patch.</i>
