- Used as a term of endearment or affectionate form of address.
- A person with whom someone is having a romantic relationship.
- Denoting an arrangement or agreement reached privately by two sides in an unofficial or illicit way.
- A very attractive or seductive looking woman.





Synonyms of "Sweetheart" as a noun (35 Words)

<u>admirer</u>	A person who admires; someone who esteems or respects or approves. <i>She s got a secret admirer</i> .
beau	A man who is the lover of a girl or young woman.
beauty	A beautiful woman. Beauty treatment.
<u>beloved</u>	A beloved person used as terms of endearment. <i>He watched his beloved from afar.</i>
<u>boyfriend</u>	A man who is the lover of a man or woman. A boyfriend cardigan.
<u>darling</u>	Used as an affectionate form of address to a beloved person. <i>He s such a darling</i> .



<u>dear</u>	A sweet or endearing person. Don t you worry dear .
dear one	A beloved person; used as terms of endearment.
dearest	A beloved person; used as terms of endearment. You make me so happy dearest .
<u>dish</u>	The food contained or served in a dish. Marriage was scarcely his dish .
endearing person	A human body (usually including the clothing.
<u>girlfriend</u>	A girl or young woman with whom a man is romantically involved. <i>He lives with his girlfriend</i> .
inamorata	A person's female lover. His new inamorata is a twenty two year old mannequin named Jennifer.
inamorato	A person's male lover. Her days were spent dallying with her inamorato .
knockout	An act of knocking someone out, especially in boxing. <i>He must have been a knockout when he was young.</i>
lady friend	A woman of the peerage in Britain.
lady love	A woman of the peerage in Britain.
looker	A person with a specified appearance. It depends on whether you are a listener a looker or a doer.
love	A person or thing that one loves. She was his first love .
loved one	Any object of warm affection or devotion.
lover	A significant other to whom you are not related by marriage. I think she had a secret lover .
lulu	An outstanding example of a particular type of person or thing. <i>As far as nightmares went this one was a lulu.</i>
man friend	Someone who serves in the armed forces; a member of a military force.
mantrap	A seductive woman.
<u>paramour</u>	A woman who cohabits with an important man.
peach	A pinkish yellow colour like that of a peach. A peach satin nightdress.
ravisher	Someone who assaults others sexually.
smasher	A person or device that breaks something up. <i>He scored a smasher</i> .



<u>steady</u>	A person loved by another person. His steady chucked him two weeks ago.
stunner	An amazing turn of events. The stunner was what happened on Saturday.
<u>suitor</u>	A man who courts a woman. <i>The company agreed to negotiate with its suitor.</i>
<u>sweet</u>	The sweet part or element of something. A sweet shop.
sweetie	Used as a term of endearment.
truelove	A person loved by another person.
woman friend	A human female employed to do housework.

for services.
