- *A person loved by another person.*
- *Any well-liked individual.*
- *A particularly lovable or pleasing person or thing.*
- *Used as a term of endearment or affectionate form of address.*
- *A person with whom someone is having a romantic relationship.*
- *Denoting an arrangement or agreement reached privately by two sides in an unofficial or illicit way.*
- *A very attractive or seductive looking woman.*



## Synonyms of "Sweetheart" as a noun (35 Words)

**admirer**

A person who admires; someone who esteems or respects or approves.  
*She s got a secret **admirer**.*

**beau**

A man who is the lover of a girl or young woman.

**beauty**

A beautiful woman.  
**Beauty** treatment.

**beloved**

A beloved person used as terms of endearment.  
*He watched his **beloved** from afar.*

**boyfriend**

A man who is the lover of a man or woman.  
A **boyfriend** cardigan.

**darling**

Used as an affectionate form of address to a beloved person.  
*He s such a **darling**.*

<b>dear</b>	A sweet or endearing person. <i>Don't you worry <b>dear</b>.</i>
<b>dear one</b>	A beloved person; used as terms of endearment.
<b>dearest</b>	A beloved person; used as terms of endearment. <i>You make me so happy <b>dearest</b>.</i>
<b>dish</b>	The food contained or served in a dish. <i>Marriage was scarcely his <b>dish</b>.</i>
<b>endearing person</b>	A human body (usually including the clothing).
<b>girlfriend</b>	A girl or young woman with whom a man is romantically involved. <i>He lives with his <b>girlfriend</b>.</i>
<b>inamorata</b>	A person's female lover. <i>His new <b>inamorata</b> is a twenty two year old mannequin named Jennifer.</i>
<b>inamorato</b>	A person's male lover. <i>Her days were spent dallying with her <b>inamorato</b>.</i>
<b>knockout</b>	An act of knocking someone out, especially in boxing. <i>He must have been a <b>knockout</b> when he was young.</i>
<b>lady friend</b>	A woman of the peerage in Britain.
<b>lady love</b>	A woman of the peerage in Britain.
<b>looker</b>	A person with a specified appearance. <i>It depends on whether you are a listener a <b>looker</b> or a doer.</i>
<b>love</b>	A person or thing that one loves. <i>She was his first <b>love</b>.</i>
<b>loved one</b>	Any object of warm affection or devotion.
<b>lover</b>	A significant other to whom you are not related by marriage. <i>I think she had a secret <b>lover</b>.</i>
<b>lulu</b>	An outstanding example of a particular type of person or thing. <i>As far as nightmares went this one was a <b>lulu</b>.</i>
<b>man friend</b>	Someone who serves in the armed forces; a member of a military force.
<b>mantrap</b>	A seductive woman.
<b>paramour</b>	A woman who cohabits with an important man.
<b>peach</b>	A pinkish yellow colour like that of a peach. <i>A <b>peach</b> satin nightdress.</i>
<b>ravisher</b>	Someone who assaults others sexually.
<b>smasher</b>	A person or device that breaks something up. <i>He scored a <b>smasher</b>.</i>

<b>steady</b>	A person loved by another person. <i>His <b>steady</b> chucked him two weeks ago.</i>
<b>stunner</b>	An amazing turn of events. <i>The <b>stunner</b> was what happened on Saturday.</i>
<b>suitor</b>	A man who courts a woman. <i>The company agreed to negotiate with its <b>suitor</b>.</i>
<b>sweet</b>	The sweet part or element of something. <i>A <b>sweet</b> shop.</i>
<b>sweetie</b>	Used as a term of endearment.
<b>truelove</b>	A person loved by another person.
<b>woman friend</b>	A human female employed to do housework.



## Usage Examples of "Sweetheart" as a noun

- *The pair were childhood sweethearts.*
- *He's a sweetheart.*
- *The government has long extended sweetheart contracts to corporations in exchange*

*for services.*

- *Don't worry, sweetheart, I've got it all worked out.*
