- *Denoting an arrangement or agreement reached privately by two sides in an unofficial or illicit way.*
- *A very attractive or seductive looking woman.*

[admirer](#)

A person who admires; someone who esteems or respects or approves.
*She s got a secret **admirer**.*

beau

A man who is the lover of a girl or young woman.

beauty

A beautiful woman.

Beauty treatment.

[beloved](#)

A beloved person used as terms of endearment.

*He watched his **beloved** from afar.*

[boyfriend](#)

A man who is the lover of a man or woman.

A **boyfriend** cardigan.

[darling](#)

Used as an affectionate form of address to a beloved person.

*He s such a **darling**.*

dear	A sweet or endearing person. <i>Don't you worry dear.</i>
dear one	A beloved person; used as terms of endearment.
dearest	A beloved person; used as terms of endearment. <i>You make me so happy dearest.</i>
dish	The food contained or served in a dish. <i>Marriage was scarcely his dish.</i>
endearing person	A human body (usually including the clothing).
girlfriend	A girl or young woman with whom a man is romantically involved. <i>He lives with his girlfriend.</i>
inamorata	A person's female lover. <i>His new inamorata is a twenty two year old mannequin named Jennifer.</i>
inamorato	A person's male lover. <i>Her days were spent dallying with her inamorato.</i>
knockout	An act of knocking someone out, especially in boxing. <i>He must have been a knockout when he was young.</i>
lady friend	A woman of the peerage in Britain.
lady love	A woman of the peerage in Britain.
looker	A person with a specified appearance. <i>It depends on whether you are a listener a looker or a doer.</i>
love	A person or thing that one loves. <i>She was his first love.</i>
loved one	Any object of warm affection or devotion.
lover	A significant other to whom you are not related by marriage. <i>I think she had a secret lover.</i>
lulu	An outstanding example of a particular type of person or thing. <i>As far as nightmares went this one was a lulu.</i>
man friend	Someone who serves in the armed forces; a member of a military force.
mantrap	A seductive woman.
paramour	A woman who cohabits with an important man.
peach	A pinkish yellow colour like that of a peach. <i>A peach satin nightdress.</i>
ravisher	Someone who assaults others sexually.
smasher	A person or device that breaks something up. <i>He scored a smasher.</i>

<u>steady</u>	A person loved by another person. <i>His steady chucked him two weeks ago.</i>
stunner	An amazing turn of events. <i>The stunner was what happened on Saturday.</i>
<u>suitor</u>	A man who courts a woman. <i>The company agreed to negotiate with its suitor.</i>
<u>sweet</u>	The sweet part or element of something. <i>A sweet shop.</i>
sweetie	Used as a term of endearment.
truelove	A person loved by another person.
woman friend	A human female employed to do housework.



Usage Examples of "Sweetheart" as a noun

- *The pair were childhood sweethearts.*
- *He's a sweetheart.*
- *The government has long extended sweetheart contracts to corporations in exchange*

for services.

- *Don't worry, sweetheart, I've got it all worked out.*
- *He is an absolute sweetheart.*
