- *The quality of giving pleasure.*
- *A dish served as the last course of a meal.*
- *English phonetician; one of the founders of modern phonetics (1845-1912).*

<b>bouquet</b>	An expression of approval; a compliment. <i>The aperitif has a faint <b>bouquet</b> of almonds.</i>
<b>euphony</b>	The quality of being pleasing to the ear. <i>The poet put <b>euphony</b> before mere factuality.</i>
<b>fragrance</b>	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property. <i>Men who don't customarily wear <b>fragrance</b>.</i>
<b>fragrancy</b>	Fragrance.
<b>lyricism</b>	An artist's expression of emotion in an imaginative and beautiful way; the quality of being lyrical. <i>The lush <b>lyricism</b> of the adagio sections of the second movement.</i>
<b>melodiousness</b>	The property of having a melody.
<b>musicality</b>	The quality of having a pleasant sound; melodiousness. <i>Her beautiful rich tone and innate <b>musicality</b>.</i>

<b>musicalness</b>	The property of sounding like music.
<b>pleasantness</b>	The feeling caused by agreeable stimuli; one pole of a continuum of states of feeling. <i>The <b>pleasantness</b> of a cool breeze on a hot summer day.</i>
<b>redolence</b>	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property.
<b>sugariness</b>	The sweetness of sugar.
<b>sweet</b>	A small shaped piece of sweet food made with sugar. <i>A <b>sweet</b> shop.</i>
<b>tunefulness</b>	The property of having a melody.

- *I've just got to go, sweetness.*

<b>flavorful</b>	Full of flavor.
<b>fragrance</b>	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property. <i>Men who don't customarily wear <b>fragrance</b>.</i>
<b>fragrant</b>	Pleasant-smelling. <i>She gathered the <b>fragrant</b> blooms.</i>
<b>lovable</b>	Having characteristics that attract love or affection. <i>A naughty but <b>lovable</b> child.</i>
<b>mellifluous</b>	(of a sound) pleasingly smooth and musical to hear. <i>Her low <b>mellifluous</b> voice.</i>
<b>musky</b>	Having a smell or taste like that of musk.
<b>odoriferous</b>	Having a natural fragrance. <i><b>Odoriferous</b> spices.</i>
<b>odorous</b>	Emitting an odor. <i><b>Odorous</b> salt pork and weevily hardtack.</i>
<b>perfume</b>	Apply perfume to. <i>Her hair was oiled and <b>perfumed</b>.</i>
<b>pudding</b>	Any of various soft thick unsweetened baked dishes. <i>A rice <b>pudding</b>.</i>
<b>redolent</b>	Strongly reminiscent or suggestive of. <i>Cannot forbear to close on this <b>redolent</b> literary note.</i>
<b>saccharine</b>	Excessively sweet or sentimental. <i><b>Saccharine</b> music.</i>
<b>scent</b>	Impart a pleasant scent to. <i>A shark can <b>scent</b> blood from well over half a kilometre away.</i>
<b>seraphic</b>	Of or relating to an angel of the first order. <i>A <b>seraphic</b> smile.</i>
<b>smell</b>	A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent. <i>If I don't get a bath soon I'll start to <b>smell</b>.</i>
<b>sugar</b>	Sweeten sprinkle or coat with sugar. <i>I'll have mine black with two <b>sugars</b>.</i>
<b>tasty</b>	Pleasing to the sense of taste. <i>A <b>tasty</b> snack.</i>
