- *Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-importance.*



Synonyms of "Swollen" as an adjective (6 Words)

conceited

Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-importance.

*An attitude of self **conceited** arrogance.*

egotistic	Characteristic of those having an inflated idea of their own importance. <i>An egotistical disregard of others.</i>
<u>egotistical</u>	Excessively conceited or absorbed in oneself; self-centred. <i>An egotistical disregard of others.</i>
self-conceited	Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-importance.
swollen-headed	Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-importance.
vain	Unproductive of success. <i>Vain about her clothes.</i>



Usage Examples of "Swollen" as an adjective

- *Growing ever more swollen-headed and arbitrary.*
- *So swollen by victory that he was unfit for normal duty.*



Associations of "Swollen" (30 Words)

abdomen	The region of the body of a vertebrate between the thorax and the pelvis.
adipose	Composed of animal fat. <i>Adipose tissue constitutes the fat of meat.</i>
balloon	Travel by hot air balloon. <i>The trousers ballooned out below his waist.</i>
belly	A pig's belly as food especially as a traded commodity. <i>His fat belly stuck out over his trousers.</i>
<u>buxom</u>	(of a woman's body) having a large bosom and pleasing curves. <i>A buxom blonde.</i>
<u>chubby</u>	Plump and rounded. <i>A chubby child.</i>
conceited	Excessively proud of oneself; vain. <i>An attitude of self conceited arrogance.</i>

dietary	A regulated daily food allowance. Dietary restrictions.
distension	Swelling, especially in part of the body, caused by pressure from inside. <i>She complained of abdominal distension after meals.</i>
egocentric	An egocentric person. Egocentric loners with an overinflated sense of self worth.
eyelid	Each of the upper and lower folds of skin which cover the eye when closed.
fat	A fatty substance made from animal or plant products used in cooking. <i>A fat cigarette.</i>
fatten	Make fat or plump. <i>He could do with some good food to fatten him up.</i>
fatty	A fat person (often used as a nickname or form of address). <i>A stranger called him a fatty.</i>
fleshy	(of a person or part of the body) having a substantial amount of flesh; plump. Fleshy greeny grey leaves.
gastric	Of the stomach. Gastric ulcer.
intestine	(especially in invertebrates) the whole alimentary canal from the mouth downward. <i>The contents of the intestine.</i>
navel	A scar where the umbilical cord was attached. <i>The Incas saw Cuzco as the navel of the world.</i>
obese	Excessively fat. <i>A hugely obese young man.</i>
overweight	Having more investment in a particular area than is normal or desirable. <i>We were overweighted in technology last year.</i>
painful	Causing physical or psychological pain. <i>Their attempts at reggae are painful.</i>
paunch	A thick strong mat used to give protection from chafing on a mast or spar. <i>One of the things I had to do was to paunch and skin a hare.</i>
paunchy	Having a large or protruding belly. <i>A slightly paunchy balding middle aged man.</i>
plump	Make fat or plump. <i>I was running from the kitchen to the living room plumping the cushions and getting drinks in place.</i>
portly	Of a stately or dignified appearance and manner. <i>He was a man of portly presence.</i>

- pudgy** (of a person or part of their body) rather fat.
*His **pudgy** fingers.*
- rotund** Round or spherical.
***Orotund** tones.*
- snobbish** Relating to, characteristic of, or like a snob.
*The writer takes a rather **snobbish** tone.*
- tubby** Short and plump.
*Historic classical recordings with a **tubby** overall sound.*
