An egotistical disregard of others.


self-conceited Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-

importance.


vain Unproductive of success. Vain about her clothes.

abdomen The region of the body of a vertebrate between the thorax and the pelvis.

adipose Composed of animal fat.

Adipose tissue constitutes the fat of meat.

balloon Travel by hot air balloon.

belly A pig s belly as food especially as a traded commodity.

buxom (of a woman's body) having a large bosom and pleasing curves.

eyelid Each of the upper and lower folds of skin which cover the eye when closed.

fat A fatty substance made from animal or plant products used in cooking.

A **fat** cigarette.

fatten Make fat or plump.

He could do with some good food to **fatten** him up.

fatty A fat person (often used as a nickname or form of address.

A stranger called him a **fatty**.

fleshy (of a person or part of the body) having a substantial amount of flesh; plump.

Fleshy greeny grey leaves.

Of the stomach.

gastric Gastric ulcer.

(especially in invertebrates) the whole alimentary canal from the mouth

intestine downward.

The contents of the **intestine**.

navel A scar where the umbilical cord was attached.

The Incas saw Cuzco as the **navel** of the world.

Excessively fat.

obese A hugely obese young man.

overweight Having more investment in a particular area than is normal or desirable.

We were **overweight**ed in technology last year.

Causing physical or psychological pain.

Their attempts at reggae are **painful**.

paunch A thick strong mat used to give protection from chafing on a mast or spar.

One of the things I had to do was to **paunch** and skin a hare.

Having a large or protruding belly.

A slightly **paunchy** balding middle aged man.

Make fat or plump.

plump I was running from the kitchen to the living room **plump**ing the cushions and

getting drinks in place.

of a stately or dignified appearance and manner.

He was a man of **portly** presence.



(of a person or part of their body) rather fat. pudgy

His **pudgy** fingers.

 $Round\ or\ spherical.$ rotund

Orotund tones.
