#### Symbol in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

### Symbol in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am symboling or symbolling	We are symboling or symbolling
You <b>are symboling or symbolling</b>	You are symboling or symbolling
He/She/It is symboling or symbolling	They are symboling or symbolling

#### Symbol in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have symboled or symbolled	We have symboled or symbolled
You have symboled or symbolled	You have symboled or symbolled
He/She/It has symboled or symbolled	They have symboled or symbolled

#### Symbol in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been symboling or symbolling	We have been symboling or symbolling
You have been symboling or symbolling	You have been symboling or symbolling
He/She/It <b>has been symboling or</b> <b>symbolling</b>	They have been symboling or symbolling

#### Symbol in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I symboled or symbolled	We <b>symboled or symbolled</b>
You <b>symboled or symbolled</b>	You symboled or symbolled
He/She/It symboled or symbolled	They symboled or symbolled



## Symbol in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I was symboling or symbolling	We were symboling or symbolling
You were symboling or symbolling	You were symboling or symbolling
He/She/It was symboling or symbolling	They were symboling or symbolling

#### Symbol in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had symboled or symbolled	We had symboled or symbolled
You had symboled or symbolled	You had symboled or symbolled
He/She/It had symboled or symbolled	I They had symboled or symbolled

#### Symbol in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been symboling or symbolling	We had been symboling or symbolling
You had been symboling or symbolling	You <b>had been symboling or symbolling</b>
He/She/It <b>had been symboling or</b> <b>symbolling</b>	They had been symboling or symbolling

## Symbol in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will symbol	We will symbol
You <b>will symbol</b>	You <b>will symbol</b>
He/She/It will symbol	They will symbol

## Symbol in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be symboling or symbolling	We will be symboling or symbolling
You <b>will be symboling or symbolling</b>	You will be symboling or symbolling
He/She/It will be symboling or symbolling	They will be symboling or symbolling



# Symbol in Future Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have symboled or symbolled	We will have symboled or symbolled
You <b>will have symboled or symbolled</b>	You will have symboled or symbolled
He/She/It will have symboled or symbolled	I They will have symboled or symbolled

# Symbol in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been symboling or symbolling	We <b>will have been symboling or</b> symbolling
You <b>will have been symboling or</b>	You <b>will have been symboling or</b>
<b>symbolling</b>	<b>symbolling</b>
He/She/It <b>will have been symboling or</b>	They <b>will have been symboling or</b>
<b>symbolling</b>	<b>symbolling</b>
