Infinitive	to symptommatize
Present Tense	symptommatize / symptommatizes
Past Tense	symptommatized
Present Participle	symptommatizing
Past Participle	symptommatized

Conjugate Symptommatize

Symptommatize in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **symptomate** We **symptomate**
You **symptomate** You **symptomate**
He/She/It **symptomates** They **symptomate**

Symptomate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am symptomating** We **are symptomating**
You **are symptomating** You **are symptomating**
He/She/It **is symptomating** They **are symptomating**

Symptomate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have symptomated** We **have symptomated**
You **have symptomated** You **have symptomated**
He/She/It **has symptomated** They **have symptomated**

Symptomate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been symptomating** We **have been symptomating**
You **have been symptomating** You **have been symptomating**
He/She/It **has been symptomating** They **have been symptomating**

Symptomate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **symptomated** We **symptomated**
You **symptomated** You **symptomated**
He/She/It **symptomated** They **symptomated**

Symptomate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was symptomatizing We were symptomatizing
You were symptomatizing You were symptomatizing
He/She/It was symptomatizing They were symptomatizing

Symptomatize in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had symptomatized We had symptomatized
You had symptomatized You had symptomatized
He/She/It had symptomatized They had symptomatized

Symptomatize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been symptomatizing We had been symptomatizing
You had been symptomatizing You had been symptomatizing
He/She/It had been symptomatizing They had been symptomatizing

Symptomatize in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will symptomatize We will symptomatize
You will symptomatize You will symptomatize
He/She/It will symptomatize They will symptomatize

Symptomatize in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be symptomatizing We will be symptomatizing
You will be symptomatizing You will be symptomatizing
He/She/It will be symptomatizing They will be symptomatizing

Symptomatize in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have symptomatized

We will have symptomatized

You will have symptomatized

You will have symptomatized

He/She/It will have symptomatized **They will have symptomatized**

Symptomatize in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been symptomatizing

We will have been symptomatizing

You will have been symptomatizing

You will have been symptomatizing

He/She/It will have been symptomatizing **They will have been symptomatizing**
