Definitions of "Sync" as a verb

- *Synchronize.*
- *Make synchronous and adjust in time or manner.*



Synonyms of "Sync" as a verb (2 Words)

synchronise Happen at the same time.

Cause to indicate the same time or rate.

synchronize You can **synchronize** your calendar with your GPS device and be alerted when you need to leave for an appointment.



Usage Examples of "Sync" as a verb

- *Let's synchronize our efforts.*
- *The flash needs to be synced to your camera.*



Associations of "Sync" (30 Words)

activate	Make (something) active or operative. <i>A DNA repair enzyme that is activated by visible light.</i>
automatically	In a mechanical manner; by a mechanism. <i>The winners of the Division 2 final are not automatically promoted.</i>
coexisting	Existing at the same time.
<u>coincide</u>	Occur at the same time. <i>The two events coincided.</i>
<u>coincidence</u>	The quality of occupying the same position or area in space. <i>The interval determining the coincidence gate is adjustable.</i>
coincident	Occurring or operating at the same time. <i>A series of coincident events.</i>
<u>coincidental</u>	Happening or existing at the same time. <i>It s convenient that his plan is coincidental with the group s closure.</i>

<u>concomitant</u>	Naturally accompanying or associated. <i>Concomitant with his obsession with dirt was a desire for order.</i>
concurrent	Occurring or operating at the same time. <i>There are three concurrent art fairs around the city.</i>
concurrently	Overlapping in duration. <i>Journal articles published concurrently with the exhibition.</i>
<u>congruent</u>	(of figures) identical in form; coinciding exactly when superimposed. <i>Institutional and departmental objectives are very largely congruent.</i>
<u>contemporaneous</u>	Occurring in the same period of time. <i>Pythagoras was contemporaneous with Buddha.</i>
<u>contemporary</u>	Characteristic of the present. <i>He was a contemporary of Darwin.</i>
cooperation	The formation and operation of cooperatives. <i>Their cooperation with us was essential for the success of our mission.</i>
<u>cooperative</u>	An association formed and operated for the benefit of those using it. <i>They have been extremely considerate polite and cooperative.</i>
enroll	Register formally as a participant or member.
<u>equalize</u>	Become equal to a specified or standard level. <i>Britain is required to equalize pension rights between men and women.</i>
<u>equate</u>	Cause (two or more things) to be the same in quantity or value. <i>Customers equate their name with quality.</i>
hap	An accidental happening. <i>What is happening.</i>
<u>identical</u>	Being the exact same one; not any other. <i>Identical triangles.</i>
incidentally	Introducing a different topic. <i>Incidentally I won't go to the party.</i>
liken	Point out the resemblance of someone or something to. <i>Racism is likened to a contagious disease.</i>
occur	Exist or be found to be present in a place or under a particular set of conditions. <i>Sexism occurs in many workplaces.</i>
same	Same in identity. <i>Two boxes having the same dimensions.</i>

- simultaneous** Occurring or operating at the same time.
*A **simultaneous** withdrawal of troops.*
- simultaneously** At the same instant.
*It works **simultaneously** as character study teen drama and sci fi thriller.*
- synchronism** The relation that exists when things occur at the same time.
- synchronize** Cause to indicate the same time or rate.
*The clocks **synchronize**.*
- synchronous** Making or denoting an orbit around the earth or another celestial body in which one revolution is completed in the period taken for the body to rotate about its axis.
*Glaciations were approximately **synchronous** in both hemispheres.*
- together** At the same time.
*Mix **together** the soya sauce and sesame oil.*
