
Sync as a Verb

- Make synchronous and adjust in time or manner.







Synonyms of "Sync" as a verb (2 Words)

synchronise Happen at the same time.

Cause to indicate the same time or rate. <u>synchronize</u> You can *synchronize* your calendar with your GPS device and be alerted when you need to leave for an appointment.



Usage Examples of "Sync" as a verb

- Let's synchronize our efforts.
- The flash needs to be synced to your camera.





Associations of "Sync" (30 Words)

activate	Make (something) active or operative. A DNA repair enzyme that is activate d by visible light.
automatically	In a mechanical manner; by a mechanism. The winners of the Division 2 final are not automatically promoted.
coexisting	Existing at the same time.
<u>coincide</u>	Occur at the same time. <i>The two events coincided</i> .
<u>coincidence</u>	The quality of occupying the same position or area in space. The interval determining the coincidence gate is adjustable.
coincident	Occurring or operating at the same time. A series of coincident events.
<u>coincidental</u>	Happening or existing at the same time. It s convenient that his plan is coincidental with the group s closure



<u>concomitant</u>	Naturally accompanying or associated. Concomitant with his obsession with dirt was a desire for order.
concurrent	Occurring or operating at the same time. There are three concurrent art fairs around the city.
concurrently	Overlapping in duration. Journal articles published concurrently with the exhibition.
<u>congruent</u>	(of figures) identical in form; coinciding exactly when superimposed. Institutional and departmental objectives are very largely congruent .
<u>contemporaneous</u>	Occurring in the same period of time. <i>Pythagoras was contemporaneous</i> with Buddha.
<u>contemporary</u>	Characteristic of the present. He was a contemporary of Darwin.
cooperation	The formation and operation of cooperatives. Their cooperation with us was essential for the success of our mission.
<u>cooperative</u>	An association formed and operated for the benefit of those using it. They have been extremely considerate polite and cooperative .
enroll	Register formally as a participant or member.
<u>equalize</u>	Become equal to a specified or standard level. Britain is required to equalize pension rights between men and women.
<u>equate</u>	Cause (two or more things) to be the same in quantity or value. <i>Customers</i> equate their name with quality.
hap	An accidental happening. What is hap pening.
<u>identical</u>	Being the exact same one; not any other. <i>Identical</i> triangles.
incidentally	Introducing a different topic. <i>Incidentally</i> I won t go to the party.
liken	Point out the resemblance of someone or something to. Racism is liken ed to a contagious disease.
occur	Exist or be found to be present in a place or under a particular set of conditions. Sexism occur s in many workplaces.
same	Same in identity. Two boxes having the same dimensions.



<u>simultaneous</u>	Occurring or operating at the same time. A simultaneous withdrawal of troops.
simultaneously	At the same instant. It works simultaneously as character study teen drama and sci fi thriller.
synchronism	The relation that exists when things occur at the same time.
<u>synchronize</u>	Cause to indicate the same time or rate. <i>The clocks synchronize.</i>
synchronous	Making or denoting an orbit around the earth or another celestial body in which one revolution is completed in the period taken for the body to rotate about its axis. <i>Glaciations were approximately</i> synchronous in both hemispheres.
together	At the same time. Mix together the soya sauce and sesame oil.
