<b>constitutive</b>	Having the power to establish or give organized existence to something. <i>Language is <b>constitutive</b> of thought.</i>
<b>depend</b>	Be grammatically dependent on. <i>We can <b>depend</b> on her to deliver a quality product.</i>
<b>dilution</b>	A liquid that has been diluted. <i>The antibody was applied at a <b>dilution</b> of 1 50.</i>
<b>divisor</b>	One of two or more integers that can be exactly divided into another integer. <i>The greatest common <b>divisor</b>.</i>

<b>element</b>	Each of more than one hundred substances that cannot be chemically interconverted or broken down into simpler substances and are primary constituents of matter Each element is distinguished by its atomic number i.e the number of protons in the nuclei of its atoms. <i>Extreme right wing <b>elements</b> in the army.</i>
<b>elemental</b>	(of an emotion) powerful and primitive. <i>A thunderstorm is the inevitable outcome of battling <b>elemental</b> forces.</i>
<b>essence</b>	Any substance possessing to a high degree the predominant properties of a plant or drug or other natural product from which it is extracted. <i>Conflict is the <b>essence</b> of drama.</i>
<b>feature</b>	Have as a feature. <i>The hotel <b>features</b> a large lounge a sauna and a coin operated solarium.</i>
<b>gene</b>	Genetics a segment of DNA that is involved in producing a polypeptide chain it can include regions preceding and following the coding DNA as well as introns between the exons it is considered a unit of heredity. <i>Playing tennis is in my <b>genes</b>.</i>
<b>ingredient</b>	An abstract part of something. <i>Pork is an important <b>ingredient</b> in many stir fried dishes.</i>
<b>mainly</b>	For the most part. <i>He is <b>mainly</b> interested in butterflies.</i>
<b>makeup</b>	An event that is substituted for a previously cancelled event. <i>The two teams played a <b>makeup</b> one week later.</i>
<b>militate</b>	(of a fact or circumstance) be a powerful or conclusive factor in preventing. <i>These fundamental differences will <b>militate</b> against the two communities coming together.</i>
<b>module</b>	One of the inherent cognitive or perceptual powers of the mind. <i>A networking <b>module</b>.</i>
<b>qualitative</b>	Of high quality; excellent. <i>A <b>qualitative</b> change in the undergraduate curriculum.</i>
<b>quintessence</b>	The fifth and highest element after air and earth and fire and water; was believed to be the substance composing all heavenly bodies. <i>We were all brought up to believe that advertising is the <b>quintessence</b> of marketing.</i>
<b>receptor</b>	An organ or cell able to respond to light, heat, or other external stimulus and transmit a signal to a sensory nerve. <i>The retina of the octopus has up to 20 million light <b>receptors</b>.</i>
<b>redefine</b>	Give a new or different definition of (a word). <i>She <b>redefined</b> his duties.</i>

<b>scarify</b>	Break up. <i>The men in some African tribes <b>scarify</b> their faces.</i>
<b>social</b>	An informal social gathering especially one organized by the members of a particular club or group. <i>Her mother is a lady of the highest <b>social</b> standing.</i>
<b>strongly</b>	In a powerful manner. <i>The car smelled <b>strongly</b> of whisky.</i>
<b>tectonic</b>	Relating to building or construction. <i>The last decade has witnessed a <b>tectonic</b> shift in world affairs.</i>
