element	Each of more than one hundred substances that cannot be chemically interconverted or broken down into simpler substances and are primary constituents of matter Each element is distinguished by its atomic number i.e the number of protons in the nuclei of its atoms. <i>Extreme right wing elements in the army.</i>
elemental	(of an emotion) powerful and primitive. <i>A thunderstorm is the inevitable outcome of battling elemental forces.</i>
essence	Any substance possessing to a high degree the predominant properties of a plant or drug or other natural product from which it is extracted. <i>Conflict is the essence of drama.</i>
feature	Have as a feature. <i>The hotel features a large lounge a sauna and a coin operated solarium.</i>
gene	Genetics a segment of DNA that is involved in producing a polypeptide chain it can include regions preceding and following the coding DNA as well as introns between the exons it is considered a unit of heredity. <i>Playing tennis is in my genes.</i>
ingredient	An abstract part of something. <i>Pork is an important ingredient in many stir fried dishes.</i>
mainly	For the most part. <i>He is mainly interested in butterflies.</i>
makeup	An event that is substituted for a previously cancelled event. <i>The two teams played a makeup one week later.</i>
militate	(of a fact or circumstance) be a powerful or conclusive factor in preventing. <i>These fundamental differences will militate against the two communities coming together.</i>
module	One of the inherent cognitive or perceptual powers of the mind. <i>A networking module.</i>
qualitative	Of high quality; excellent. <i>A qualitative change in the undergraduate curriculum.</i>
quintessence	The fifth and highest element after air and earth and fire and water; was believed to be the substance composing all heavenly bodies. <i>We were all brought up to believe that advertising is the quintessence of marketing.</i>
receptor	An organ or cell able to respond to light, heat, or other external stimulus and transmit a signal to a sensory nerve. <i>The retina of the octopus has up to 20 million light receptors.</i>
redefine	Give a new or different definition of (a word). <i>She redefined his duties.</i>

scarify	Break up. <i>The men in some African tribes scarify their faces.</i>
