<u>observe</u>	Observe with care or pay close attention to. A minute s silence will be observe d.



observer	A person trained to spot and identify enemy aircraft or to reconnoitre enemy positions from the air. <i>Elections scrutinized by international observers.</i>
observing	Quick to notice; showing quick and keen perception.
optical	A pair of glasses. <i>Optical</i> illusions.
percipient	Having good insight or understanding; perceptive. He is a percipient interpreter of the public mood.
phantasm	An illusory likeness of something. The cart seemed to glide like a terrible phantasm .
sight	Take aim by looking through the sights of a gun or other device. In his sight she could do no wrong.
spectacle	A blunder that makes you look ridiculous used in the phrase make a spectacle of yourself. <i>The spectacle of a city s mass grief.</i>
<u>spectator</u>	A close observer; someone who looks at something (such as an exhibition of some kind. Around fifteen thousand spectator s came to watch the thrills and spills.
telescope	Make smaller or shorter. The novel was telescope d into a short play.
telescopic	Relating to or made with a telescope. <i>Telescopic</i> observations.
viewer	A device for looking at film transparencies or similar photographic images. <i>A slide viewer.</i>
<u>visibility</u>	The degree to which something has attracted general attention; prominence. Low visibility caused by fog.
<u>visible</u>	Visible imports or exports. Mountains visible in the distance.
<u>visual</u>	Visible- Shakespeare. Visual powers.
<u>watch</u>	The officers and crew on duty during a watch. They watch ed as the murderer was executed.
