<a href="#">beholder</a>	A person who becomes aware (of things or events) through the senses. <i>The building and landscape can elicit imaginative responses from the <b>beholder</b>.</i>
<b>discovered</b>	Discovered or determined by scientific observation. <i>The <b>discovered</b> behavior norms.</i>
<b>experimenter</b>	A person who tries out new ideas, methods, or activities. <i>Early <b>experimenters</b> with structure and harmony.</i>
<b>eye</b>	The visual or light detecting organ of many invertebrate animals that corresponds to the eye of humans and vertebrate animals. <i>Margot saw the women <b>eyeing</b> up her boyfriend.</i>
<b>find</b>	Make a discovery make a new finding. <i>Phobia sufferers often <b>find</b> themselves virtual prisoners in their own home.</i>
<b>look</b>	Of a building or room have an outlook in a specified direction. <i>Poirot <b>looked</b> a question.</i>
<b>lookout</b>	A place from which to keep watch or view the landscape. <i>A <b>lookout</b> point with breathtaking views.</i>
<b>macroscopic</b>	Visible to the naked eye; not microscopic.
<b>microscopy</b>	The use of the microscope.
<b>observant</b>	Adhering strictly to the rules of a particular religion, especially Judaism. <i>Her <b>observant</b> eye took in every detail.</i>
<b>observation</b>	The ability to notice things, especially significant details. <i>Detailed <b>observations</b> were carried out on the students behaviour.</i>
<b>observatory</b>	A position or building that gives an extensive view.
<a href="#">observe</a>	Observe with care or pay close attention to. <i>It s chilly she <b>observed</b>.</i>

<b>observer</b>	A person trained to spot and identify enemy aircraft or to reconnoitre enemy positions from the air. <i>Elections scrutinized by international <b>observers</b>.</i>
<b>observing</b>	Quick to notice; showing quick and keen perception.
<b>optical</b>	Constructed to assist sight. <i><b>Optical</b> illusions.</i>
<b>percipient</b>	Characterized by ease and quickness in perceiving. <i>He is a <b>percipient</b> interpreter of the public mood.</i>
<b>phantasm</b>	Something existing in perception only. <i>The cart seemed to glide like a terrible <b>phantasm</b>.</i>
<b>sight</b>	Take a detailed visual measurement of something with or as with a sight. <i>John was a familiar <b>sight</b> in the bar for many years.</i>
<b>spectacle</b>	A blunder that makes you look ridiculous used in the phrase make a spectacle of yourself. <i>The tragic <b>spectacle</b> of cripples trying to escape.</i>
<a href="#"><u>spectator</u></a>	A close observer; someone who looks at something (such as an exhibition of some kind). <i>The <b>spectators</b> applauded the performance.</i>
<b>telescope</b>	Crush together or collapse. <i>Five steel sections that <b>telescope</b> into one another.</i>
<b>telescopic</b>	Visible through a telescope. <i>A bright star with a <b>telescopic</b> companion.</i>
<b>viewer</b>	A person watching television or a film. <i>The <b>viewer</b> of paintings or sculpture.</i>
<a href="#"><u>visibility</u></a>	Quality or fact or degree of being visible; perceptible by the eye or obvious to the eye. <i>Low <b>visibility</b> caused by fog.</i>
<a href="#"><u>visible</u></a>	Visible imports or exports. <i>A highly <b>visible</b> member of the royal entourage.</i>
<a href="#"><u>visual</u></a>	A picture, piece of film, or display used to illustrate or accompany something. <i>The music should fit the <b>visuals</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>watch</u></a>	The officers and crew on duty during a watch. <i>There aren't enough staff to <b>watch</b> him properly.</i>
<b>witness</b>	Be a witness to. <i>His writings <b>witness</b> to an inner toughness.</i>
