abstract	An abstract work of art. He loved her only in the abstract not in person.
compendium	A publication containing a variety of works. A compendium of tools.
condensation	A concise version of something, especially a text. A readable condensation of the recent literature.



<u>digest</u>	A substance or mixture obtained by digestion. A digest of their findings.
outline	The contours or bounds of an object. The chalked outline of a human body.
precis	A summary or abstract of a text or speech.
review	A report on or evaluation of a subject or past events. A review of her sentence.
<u>rundown</u>	An analysis or summary of something by a knowledgeable person. <i>He gave his teammates a rundown on the opposition.</i>
résumé	Short descriptive summary (of events.
<u>sketch</u>	A humorous or satirical drawing published in a newspaper or magazine. A hilarious sketch for their latest BBC series.
summarization	The act of preparing a summary (or an instance thereof); stating briefly and succinctly.
summary	A brief statement or account of the main points of something. <i>He gave a summary of the conclusions.</i>

Associations of "Synopsis" (30 Words)

abbreviate	Shorten (a word, phrase, or text. I decided to abbreviate my stay in Cambridge.
abbreviated	Cut short in duration. The abbreviated speech.
<u>abridge</u>	Lessen, diminish, or curtail. The new law might abridge our freedom of expression.
abridgment	A shortened version of a written work.
<u>abstract</u>	An abstract work of art. The novel was too abstract and esoteric to sustain much attention.
cartography	The science or practice of drawing maps.
<u>chart</u>	Make a chart of. The record will probably chart at about No 74.
compendium	A collection or set of similar items. A compendium of tools.



condensation	A reaction in which two molecules combine to form a larger molecule, producing a small molecule such as H ₂ O as a by-product. <i>The cloud is caused by condensation in the air</i> .
contour	Mark a map or diagram with contour lines. <i>The road contours the hillside.</i>
<u>delineate</u>	Indicate the exact position of (a border or boundary. His finger found a precisely outlined section delineate d in red marker.
denouement	The final resolution of the main complication of a literary or dramatic work. <i>I waited by the eighteenth green to see the</i> denouement .
<u>diagram</u>	Schedule the operations of a locomotive or train according to a diagram. A diagram of the living room.
doodle	Make a doodle draw aimlessly. The text was interspersed with doodle s.
draft	Select a player for a sports team through the draft. The White Sox chose him in the 13th round of the 1990 draft .
<u>drawing</u>	The act of moving a load by drawing or pulling. A series of charcoal drawing s on white paper.
<u>encapsulate</u>	Enclose (something) in or as if in a capsule. Pancreatic tumours are encapsulate d in a densely packed thicket of proteins and cells.
machination	A plot or scheme.
outline	Draw up an outline or sketch for something. The chalked outline of a human body.
plan	A drawing or diagram made by projection on a horizontal plane especially one showing the layout of a building or one floor of a building. <i>The rebels had planned turmoil and confusion.</i>
<u>plot</u>	A graph showing the relation between two variables. They concocted a plot to discredit the governor.
precis	Make a precis of a text or speech.
profile	Represent in profile by drawing or painting. A biochemical profile of blood.
prospectus	A catalog listing the courses offered by a college or university. A prospectus should contain the facts that an investor needs to make an informed decision.
recapitulate	Summarize briefly. <i>Let s recapitulate the main ideas.</i>



resume	A summary of your academic and work history. <i>The painting resumed its old condition when we restored it.</i>
<u>sketch</u>	Make a sketch of. He sketch ed a graceful bow in her direction.
<u>summarize</u>	Give a brief statement of the main points of (something. These results can be summarize d in the following table.
summary	(of a conviction) made by a judge or magistrate without a jury. <i>He gave a summary of the conclusions.</i>
<u>vignette</u>	Portray someone in the style of a vignette. A classic vignette of embassy life.
