Synonyms of "Synopsis" as a noun (13 Words)

abridgement	Curtailment of rights. <i>An abridgement of Shakespeare s Henry VI.</i>
abstract	An abstract work of art. <i>He loved her only in the abstract not in person.</i>
compendium	A publication containing a variety of works. <i>A compendium of tools.</i>
condensation	A concise version of something, especially a text. <i>A readable condensation of the recent literature.</i>

digest	A substance or mixture obtained by digestion. <i>A digest of their findings.</i>
outline	The contours or bounds of an object. <i>The chalked outline of a human body.</i>
precis	A summary or abstract of a text or speech.
review	A report on or evaluation of a subject or past events. <i>A review of her sentence.</i>
rundown	An analysis or summary of something by a knowledgeable person. <i>He gave his teammates a rundown on the opposition.</i>
résumé	Short descriptive summary (of events).
sketch	A humorous or satirical drawing published in a newspaper or magazine. <i>A hilarious sketch for their latest BBC series.</i>
summarization	The act of preparing a summary (or an instance thereof); stating briefly and succinctly.
summary	A brief statement or account of the main points of something. <i>He gave a summary of the conclusions.</i>

Usage Examples of "Synopsis" as a noun

- *A synopsis of the insurance cover provided is set out below.*

Associations of "Synopsis" (30 Words)

abbreviate	Shorten (a word, phrase, or text). <i>I decided to abbreviate my stay in Cambridge.</i>
abbreviated	Cut short in duration. <i>The abbreviated speech.</i>
abridge	Lessen, diminish, or curtail. <i>The new law might abridge our freedom of expression.</i>
abridgment	A shortened version of a written work.
abstract	An abstract work of art. <i>The novel was too abstract and esoteric to sustain much attention.</i>
cartography	The science or practice of drawing maps.
chart	Make a chart of. <i>The record will probably chart at about No 74.</i>
compendium	A collection or set of similar items. <i>A compendium of tools.</i>

condensation	A reaction in which two molecules combine to form a larger molecule, producing a small molecule such as H ₂ O as a by-product. <i>The cloud is caused by condensation in the air.</i>
contour	Mark a map or diagram with contour lines. <i>The road contours the hillside.</i>
delineate	Indicate the exact position of (a border or boundary). <i>His finger found a precisely outlined section delineated in red marker.</i>
denouement	The final resolution of the main complication of a literary or dramatic work. <i>I waited by the eighteenth green to see the denouement.</i>
diagram	Schedule the operations of a locomotive or train according to a diagram. <i>A diagram of the living room.</i>
doodle	Make a doodle draw aimlessly. <i>The text was interspersed with doodles.</i>
draft	Select a player for a sports team through the draft. <i>The White Sox chose him in the 13th round of the 1990 draft.</i>
drawing	The act of moving a load by drawing or pulling. <i>A series of charcoal drawings on white paper.</i>
encapsulate	Enclose (something) in or as if in a capsule. <i>Pancreatic tumours are encapsulated in a densely packed thicket of proteins and cells.</i>
machination	A plot or scheme.
outline	Draw up an outline or sketch for something. <i>The chalked outline of a human body.</i>
plan	A drawing or diagram made by projection on a horizontal plane especially one showing the layout of a building or one floor of a building. <i>The rebels had planned turmoil and confusion.</i>
plot	A graph showing the relation between two variables. <i>They concocted a plot to discredit the governor.</i>
precis	Make a precis of a text or speech.
profile	Represent in profile by drawing or painting. <i>A biochemical profile of blood.</i>
prospectus	A catalog listing the courses offered by a college or university. <i>A prospectus should contain the facts that an investor needs to make an informed decision.</i>
recapitulate	Summarize briefly. <i>Let s recapitulate the main ideas.</i>

resume

A summary of your academic and work history.

*The painting **resumed** its old condition when we restored it.*

sketch

Make a sketch of.

*He **sketched** a graceful bow in her direction.*

summarize

Give a brief statement of the main points of (something).

*These results can be **summarized** in the following table.*

summary

(of a conviction) made by a judge or magistrate without a jury.

*He gave a **summary** of the conclusions.*

vignette

Portray someone in the style of a vignette.

*A classic **vignette** of embassy life.*
