#### Definitions of "Syntax" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "syntax" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- The structure of statements in a computer language.
- The branch of linguistics that deals with syntax.
- A systematic orderly arrangement.
- The arrangement of words and phrases to create well-formed sentences in a language.
- Studies of the rules for forming admissible sentences.
- The grammatical arrangement of words in sentences.
- A set of rules for or an analysis of the syntax of a language.






### Synonyms of "Syntax" as a noun (2 Words)

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### Associations of "Syntax" (30 Words)

<u>abstract</u>	Give an abstract of. Abstract concepts such as love or beauty.
alliterate	(of a phrase or line of verse) contain words which begin with the same sound or letter. <i>His first and last names <b>alliterate</b>d</i> .
alphabet	A set of letters or symbols in a fixed order used to represent the basic set of speech sounds of a language, especially the set of letters from A to Z. <i>A phonetic alphabet</i> .
antonym	A word that expresses a meaning opposed to the meaning of another word in which case the two words are antonyms of each other. <i>To him the <b>antonym</b> of gay was depressed.</i>
bewitchment	A magical spell.



circumlocution	An indirect way of expressing something. <i>He used a number of poetic circumlocutions.</i>
collocation	The action of placing things side by side or in position. <i>The collocation of the two pieces.</i>
concordance	Make a concordance of a text. A <b>concordance</b> to the Bible.
correction	A drop in stock market activity or stock prices following a period of increases. Isotopic ratios are presented normalized to NBS SRM981 using a fractionation <b>correction</b> of 0 101 per a m u.
<u>derivative</u>	An arrangement or product (such as a future, option, or warrant) whose value derives from and is dependent on the value of an underlying asset, such as a commodity, currency, or security. <i>Fly tip is a <b>derivative</b> of the phrase on the fly.</i>
dictionary	A reference book containing an alphabetical list of words with information about them. <i>I ll look up love in the dictionary.</i>
diphthong	A digraph representing the sound of a diphthong or single vowel as in feat.
etymology	The study of the origin of words and the way in which their meanings have changed throughout history. <i>The etymology of the word devil.</i>
grammar	A grammar school. My old Latin <b>grammar</b> .
grammarian	A linguist who specializes in the study of grammar and syntax.
homonym	Two words are homonyms if they are pronounced or spelled the same way but have different meanings.
<u>indent</u>	The space left between the margin and the start of an indented line. An <b>indent</b> ured servant.
indentation	The formation of small pits in a surface as a consequence of corrosion. An <b>indentation</b> for each change of speaker.
lexicon	A language user's knowledge of words. <i>The size of the English <b>lexicon</b></i> .
litotes	Understatement for rhetorical effect (especially when expressing an affirmative by negating its contrary. Saying I was not a little upset when you mean I was very upset is an example of <b>litotes</b> .



<u>morphology</u>	The study of the forms of words, in particular inflected forms. <i>Grammar is organized along two main dimensions</i> <b>morphology</b> and <i>syntax</i> .
orthography	A method of representing the sounds of a language by written or printed symbols. A spoken language which has as yet no sanctioned <b>orthography</b> .
paragraph	Write about in a paragraph. All her friends were <b>paragraph</b> ed in last Monday s paper.
<u>parse</u>	Analyze syntactically by assigning a constituent structure to (a sentence. I asked a couple of students to <b>parse</b> these sentences for me.
<u>rhetoric</u>	Using language effectively to please or persuade. <i>He is using a common figure of <b>rhetoric</b> hyperbole.</i>
sentence	Pronounce a sentence on somebody in a court of law. Slander of an official carried an eight year prison <b>sentence</b> .
<u>spelling</u>	The way a word is spelled. The <b>spelling</b> of his name was influenced by French.
typo	A typographical error.
vocabulary	The body of words used in a particular language. The term became part of business <b>vocabulary</b> .
word	A word is a string of bits stored in computer memory. So many <b>word</b> s for so few ideas.
