## Associations of "Take part in" (30 Words)

<b>accept</b>	Make use of or accept for some purpose. <i>He <b>accepted</b> a pen as a present.</i>
<b>admission</b>	The fee charged for admission. <i>The surgery was performed on his second <b>admission</b> to the clinic.</i>
<b>apportion</b>	Give out as one's portion or share. <i>They did not <b>apportion</b> blame or liability to any one individual.</i>
<b>arrive</b>	Reach a destination arrive by movement or progress. <i>She <b>arrived</b> home at 7 o'clock.</i>
<b>bring</b>	Go or come after and bring or take back. <i><b>Bring</b> comments.</i>
<b>broach</b>	Raise (a difficult subject) for discussion. <i>He <b>broached</b> the subject he had been avoiding all evening.</i>
<b>deprivation</b>	The disadvantage that results from losing something. <i>Rural households could escape the worst <b>deprivations</b> of the towns.</i>
<b>deprive</b>	Depose (someone, especially a member of the clergy) from office. <i>The Archbishop <b>deprived</b> a considerable number of puritan clergymen.</i>
<b>distribution</b>	The spatial or geographic property of being scattered about over a range, area, or volume. <i>An established <b>distribution</b> channel.</i>
<b>division</b>	A group of organisms forming a subdivision of a larger category. <i>The <b>division</b> of his estates between the two branches of his family.</i>
<b>entree</b>	The principal dish of a meal. <i>She made a graceful <b>entree</b> into the ballroom.</i>
<b>fetch</b>	The action of fetching. <i>That air of his always <b>fetches</b> women.</i>
<b>fractional</b>	Small or tiny in amount. <i><b>Fractional</b> crystallization.</i>

<b>fragment</b>	Break or cause to break into fragments. <i>Small <b>fragments</b> of pottery.</i>
<b>fragmentary</b>	Consisting of small disconnected or incomplete parts. <i>Excavations have revealed <b>fragmentary</b> remains of masonry.</i>
<b>get</b>	Take vengeance on or get even. <i>You cannot <b>get</b> water out of a stone.</i>
<b>half</b>	Half a pint of beer or a similar drink. <i>I am <b>half</b> inclined to believe you.</i>
<b>have</b>	Have sex with archaic use. <i><b>Have</b> you got a job yet.</i>
<b>hold</b>	Contain or hold have within. <i>The novel <b>holds</b> many surprises.</i>
<b>invulnerable</b>	Immune to attack; impregnable. <i>No state in the region is now <b>invulnerable</b> to attack by another.</i>
<b>loot</b>	Stolen money or valuables. <i>A gang <b>looted</b> Rs 1 5 lakh from a passenger.</i>
<b>portion</b>	Your overall circumstances or condition in life (including everything that happens to you). <i>Burger joints offering huge <b>portions</b>.</i>
<b>possess</b>	Have ownership or possession of. <i>A terrible rage <b>possessed</b> her.</i>
<b>private</b>	The lowest rank in the army below lance corporal or private first class. <i>Public figures struggle to maintain a <b>private</b> life.</i>
<b>proportion</b>	Give pleasant proportions to. <i>The bleach can be diluted with water in the <b>proportion</b> one part bleach to ten parts water.</i>
<b>scarify</b>	Criticize severely and hurtfully. <i><b>Scarify</b> soil.</i>
<b>section</b>	Divide into sections. <i>Nails of round <b>section</b>.</i>
<b>share</b>	Have give or receive a share of. <i>Under the proposals investors would pay a greater <b>share</b> of the annual fees required.</i>
<b>slat</b>	Close the slats of windows. <i>Sunlight filtered dustily through the <b>slats</b> of the door.</i>
<b>uppermost</b>	At or to the highest or most important position. <i>Investors put environmental concerns <b>uppermost</b> on their list.</i>
