## Associations of "Tales" (30 Words)

<b><u>abstraction</u></b>	The act of withdrawing or removing something. <i>A series of black and white <b>abstractions</b>.</i>
<b>creativity</b>	The ability to create.
<b>daydream</b>	Indulge in a daydream. <i>Stop <b>daydreaming</b> and pay attention.</i>
<b><u>dreamer</u></b>	A person who dreams or is dreaming. <i>A rebellious young <b>dreamer</b>.</i>
<b>fairy</b>	Offensive term for an openly homosexual man. <i><b>Fairy</b> gold.</i>
<b>fancied</b>	Formed or conceived by the imagination. <i>A <b>fancied</b> wrong.</i>
<b>fanciful</b>	Highly ornamental or imaginative in design. <i>A <b>fanciful</b> mind.</i>
<b><u>fantasy</u></b>	Imagination unrestricted by reality. <i>It is ludicrous to <b>fantasy</b> disinventing the hydrogen bomb.</i>
<b>fiction</b>	A literary work based on the imagination and not necessarily on fact. <i>The notion of the country being a democracy is a polite <b>fiction</b>.</i>
<b>genie</b>	An invisible spirit mentioned in the Koran and believed by Muslims to inhabit the earth and influence mankind by appearing in the form of humans or animals.
<b>gnome</b>	A small garden ornament in the form of a bearded man with a pointed hat. <i>A grizzled <b>gnome</b> of a man.</i>
<b>idealist</b>	Someone guided more by ideals than by practical considerations. <i>Hegel described himself as an absolute <b>idealist</b>.</i>
<b>idealistic</b>	Of or relating to the philosophical doctrine of the reality of ideas. <i><b>Idealistic</b> young doctors who went to work for the rebels.</i>

<b>illusion</b>	A false idea or belief. <i>They have the <b>illusion</b> that I am very wealthy.</i>
<b>illusive</b>	Based on or having the nature of an illusion. <i>An <b>illusive</b> haven.</i>
<b>illusory</b>	Based on illusion; not real. <i>Secret activities offer presidents the alluring but often <b>illusory</b> promise that they can achieve foreign policy goals without the bothersome debate and open decision that are staples of democracy.</i>
<b><u>imaginary</u></b>	Existing only in the imagination. <i>A small child s <b>imaginary</b> friends.</i>
<b>improbable</b>	Too improbable to admit of belief. <i>The characters have <b>improbable</b> names.</i>
<b>legerdemain</b>	Skilful use of one's hands when performing conjuring tricks. <i>A classic piece of management <b>legerdemain</b>.</i>
<b>magic</b>	Move change or create by or as if by magic. <i>His parents bought him a <b>magic</b> set for Christmas.</i>
<b><u>mythical</u></b>	Based on or told of in traditional stories; lacking factual basis or historical validity. <i><b>Mythical</b> centaurs.</i>
<b>necromancy</b>	The supposed practice of communicating with the dead, especially in order to predict the future. <i>Alchemy <b>necromancy</b> and other magic practices.</i>
<b><u>props</u></b>	Proper respect. <i>Certain sectors of the music fraternity still refuse to give him <b>props</b>.</i>
<b><u>surreal</u></b>	Having the qualities of surrealism bizarre. <i>As irrational and <b>surreal</b> as a dream.</i>
<b>sylph</b>	An imaginary spirit of the air. <i>An oh so slim <b>sylph</b> dressed in a black leotard.</i>
<b><u>talisman</u></b>	An object, typically an inscribed ring or stone, that is thought to have magic powers and to bring good luck. <i>He s a quiet man off the field but on it he s our <b>talisman</b>.</i>
<b><u>tangential</u></b>	Of superficial relevance if any. <i>A <b>tangential</b> remark.</i>
<b>thaumaturgy</b>	Any art that invokes supernatural powers. <i>He attracts people by his <b>thaumaturgy</b>.</i>
<b><u>visionary</u></b>	Existing only in a vision or in the imagination. <i>He is a <b>visionary</b> keen on policy making.</i>
