Infinitive	<b>to tally</b>
Present Tense	<b>tally / tallies</b>
Past Tense	<b>tallied</b>
Present Participle	<b>tallying</b>
Past Participle	<b>tallied</b>

## Conjugate Tally

**Tally in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>tally</b>	We <b>tally</b>
You <b>tally</b>	You <b>tally</b>
He/She/It <b>tallies</b>	They <b>tally</b>

## **Tally in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am tallying</b>	We <b>are tallying</b>
You <b>are tallying</b>	You <b>are tallying</b>
He/She/It <b>is tallying</b>	They <b>are tallying</b>

## **Tally in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have tallied</b>	We <b>have tallied</b>
You <b>have tallied</b>	You <b>have tallied</b>
He/She/It <b>has tallied</b>	They <b>have tallied</b>

I <b>have been tallying</b>	We <b>have been tallying</b>
You <b>have been tallying</b>	You <b>have been tallying</b>
He/She/It <b>has been tallying</b>	They <b>have been tallying</b>

You <b>had tallied</b>	You <b>had tallied</b>
He/She/It <b>had tallied</b>	They <b>had tallied</b>

**We will have tallied**

**You will have tallied**

**They will have tallied**

**I will have been tallying**

**We will have been tallying**

**You will have been tallying**

**You will have been tallying**

**He/She/It will have been tallying**

**They will have been tallying**
