controlled	Having been limited in intensity or level; kept in check. The country s tightly controlled financial markets.
<u>docile</u>	Easily handled or managed. <i>Docile</i> pupils eager for instruction.
doctrinaire	A doctrinaire person. The administration s doctrinaire economic policy.
<u>domestic</u>	Converted or adapted to domestic use. Domestic issues such as tax rate and highway construction.
domesticate	Adapt (a wild plant or unclaimed land) to the environment. The horse was domesticate d a long time ago.
domesticated	(of an animal) tame and kept as a pet or on a farm. Domesticated crops.
dominate	Look down on. The villa dominate s the town.
dominated	Harassed by persistent nagging.



dutiful	Motivated by duty rather than desire or enthusiasm. A dutiful visit.
govern	Conduct the policy, actions, and affairs of (a state, organization, or people) with authority. <i>He was incapable of governing the country.</i>
<u>malleable</u>	Easily influenced; pliable. They are as malleable and easily led as sheep.
<u>manageable</u>	Capable of existing or taking place or proving true; possible to do. <i>Her long hair was black wavy and manageable.</i>
<u>meek</u>	Very docile- Langston Hughes. She looked meek but had the heart of a lion.
<u>mild</u>	Humble in spirit or manner suggesting retiring mildness or even cowed submissiveness. A mild sedative.
muted	In a softened tone. <i>Muted</i> trumpets.
<u>obedient</u>	Complying or willing to comply with an order or request; submissive to another's authority. The obedient colonies are heavily taxed the refractory remain unburdened.
restrained	Cool and formal in manner. Restrained in his response.
subdued	(of colour or lighting) soft and restrained. I felt strangely subdued as I drove home.
submissive	Abjectly submissive characteristic of a slave or servant. Replacing troublemakers with more submissive people.
subservience	Willingness to obey others unquestioningly. Blind subservience to authority.
<u>susceptible</u>	(of a person) easily influenced by feelings or emotions; sensitive. They only do it to tease him he s too susceptible .
tractability	The trait of being easily persuaded.
<u>tractable</u>	(of a situation or problem) easy to deal with. A tractable student.
<u>vulnerable</u>	(of a person) in need of special care, support, or protection because of age, disability, or risk of abuse or neglect. <i>We were in a vulnerable position.</i>
willing	Given or done readily. <i>He was quite willing to compromise.</i>
