starve Force someone out of (a place) or into (a specified state) by starvation.

taste Have a distinctive or characteristic taste.

Arrogance and lack of **taste** contributed to his rapid success.

taunt Provoke or challenge (someone) with insulting remarks.

Pupils began **taunt**ing her about her weight.

tease Make fun of or attempt to provoke (a person or animal) in a playful way.

The advertisement is intended to **tease** the customers.

thirst Feel the need to drink.

Tens of thousands died of **thirst** and starvation.
