bang	Leap jerk bang. <i>I went to answer a bang on the front door.</i>
botch	An embarrassing mistake. <i>He was accused of botching the job.</i>
bungle	Make a mess of, destroy or ruin. <i>It emerged that forensic police had bungled in gathering the evidence.</i>
caress	Touch or stroke lightly in a loving or endearing manner. <i>She caressed the girl s forehead.</i>
crackle	Having the surface decorated with a network of fine cracks as in crackleware. <i>A crackle glaze.</i>
dab	A brief application of a piece of absorbent material to a surface. <i>The catalogue is being dusted for your dabs.</i>
ding	Go ding dong like a bell. <i>Cash registers were dinging softly.</i>
door	A doorway. <i>He stuck his head in the doorway.</i>
encouraged	Inspired with confidence.
friction	A state of conflict between persons. <i>A considerable amount of friction between father and son.</i>
fumble	Do or handle something clumsily. <i>Just one fumble during a tyre change could separate the winners from the losers.</i>
hear	Examine or hear evidence or a case by judicial process. <i>We heard nothing from our son for five years.</i>
hearing	The act of hearing attentively. <i>They condemned him without a hearing.</i>

hit	Hit with a missile from a weapon. <i>He hit her hard in the face.</i>
intercept	An act or instance of intercepting something. <i>A second prism can be swung in to intercept the light beam.</i>
jingle	A comic verse of irregular measure. <i>The jingle of a bridle.</i>
knock	The sound of knocking as on a door or in an engine or bearing. <i>She knocked her knee painfully on the table.</i>
lightning	A flash or discharge of lightning. <i>A lightning cure for his hangover.</i>
onomatopoeia	The use of onomatopoeia for literary effect.
pang	A sudden sharp pain or painful emotion. <i>A pang of conscience.</i>
pat	Pat or squeeze fondly or playfully especially under the chin. <i>He patted him consolingly on the shoulder.</i>
ping	Hit with a pinging noise. <i>Ping your machine in the office.</i>
rap	Genre of African American music of the 1980s and 1990s in which rhyming lyrics are chanted to a musical accompaniment several forms of rap have emerged. <i>We could be here all night rapping about spiritualism.</i>
rub	An act of rubbing. <i>He rubbed a finger round the rim of his mug.</i>
slam	Dance the slam dance. <i>A stellar 12 months saw her win two slams and two Olympic gold medals and retain the number one ranking.</i>
spoil	The act of spoiling something by causing damage to it. <i>Her spoiling my dress was deliberate.</i>
strike	Undertake strike action against an employer. <i>Small conifers will strike from cuttings.</i>
touch	An act of touching someone or something. <i>Her touch on his shoulder was hesitant.</i>
wiretap	Tap a telephone or telegraph wire to get information. <i>The government illegally wiretapped the lawyers.</i>
