crackle	Having the surface decorated with a network of fine cracks as in crackleware. A <b>crackle</b> glaze.
dab	A brief application of a piece of absorbent material to a surface. The catalogue is being dusted for your <b>dab</b> s.
ding	Go ding dong like a bell. Cash registers were <b>ding</b> ing softly.
<u>door</u>	A doorway. He stuck his head in the <b>door</b> way.
encouraged	Inspired with confidence.
friction	A state of conflict between persons. A considerable amount of <b>friction</b> between father and son.
fumble	Do or handle something clumsily. Just one <b>fumble</b> during a tyre change could separate the winners from the losers.
<u>hear</u>	Examine or hear evidence or a case by judicial process. We <b>hear</b> d nothing from our son for five years.
<u>hearing</u>	The act of hearing attentively. They condemned him without a <b>hearing</b> .



hit	Hit with a missile from a weapon. <i>He <b>hit</b> her hard in the face.</i>
<u>intercept</u>	An act or instance of intercepting something. A second prism can be swung in to <b>intercept</b> the light beam.
jingle	A comic verse of irregular measure. <i>The <b>jingle</b> of a bridle.</i>
knock	The sound of knocking as on a door or in an engine or bearing. She <b>knock</b> ed her knee painfully on the table.
<u>lightning</u>	A flash or discharge of lightning. A <b>lightning</b> cure for his hangover.
<u>onomatopoeia</u>	The use of onomatopoeia for literary effect.
pang	A sudden sharp pain or painful emotion. A <b>pang</b> of conscience.
pat	Pat or squeeze fondly or playfully especially under the chin. <i>He <b>pat</b>ted him consolingly on the shoulder.</i>
ping	Hit with a pinging noise. <i>Ping</i> your machine in the office.
rap	Genre of African American music of the 1980s and 1990s in which rhyming lyrics are chanted to a musical accompaniment several forms of rap have emerged. <i>We could be here all night</i> <b>rap</b> <i>ping about spiritualism.</i>
<u>rub</u>	An act of rubbing. He <b>rub</b> bed a finger round the rim of his mug.
<u>slam</u>	Dance the slam dance. A stellar 12 months saw her win two <b>slam</b> s and two Olympic gold medals and retain the number one ranking.
spoil	The act of spoiling something by causing damage to it. <i>Her <b>spoil</b>ing my dress was deliberate.</i>
<u>strike</u>	Undertake strike action against an employer. Small conifers will <b>strike</b> from cuttings.
touch	An act of touching someone or something. Her <b>touch</b> on his shoulder was hesitant.
wiretap	Tap a telephone or telegraph wire to get information. The government illegally <b>wiretap</b> ped the lawyers.
