## Associations of "Tap into" (30 Words)

<b>bang</b>	Leap jerk bang. <i>I went to answer a <b>bang</b> on the front door.</i>
<b>botch</b>	An embarrassing mistake. <i>He was accused of <b>botching</b> the job.</i>
<b><a href="#">bungle</a></b>	Make a mess of, destroy or ruin. <i>It emerged that forensic police had <b>bungled</b> in gathering the evidence.</i>
<b><a href="#">caress</a></b>	Touch or stroke lightly in a loving or endearing manner. <i>She <b>caressed</b> the girl s forehead.</i>
<b>crackle</b>	Having the surface decorated with a network of fine cracks as in crackleware. <i>A <b>crackle</b> glaze.</i>
<b>dab</b>	A brief application of a piece of absorbent material to a surface. <i>The catalogue is being dusted for your <b>dabs</b>.</i>
<b>ding</b>	Go ding dong like a bell. <i>Cash registers were <b>dinging</b> softly.</i>
<b><a href="#">door</a></b>	A doorway. <i>He stuck his head in the <b>doorway</b>.</i>
<b>encouraged</b>	Inspired with confidence.
<b>friction</b>	A state of conflict between persons. <i>A considerable amount of <b>friction</b> between father and son.</i>
<b>fumble</b>	Do or handle something clumsily. <i>Just one <b>fumble</b> during a tyre change could separate the winners from the losers.</i>
<b><a href="#">hear</a></b>	Examine or hear evidence or a case by judicial process. <i>We <b>heard</b> nothing from our son for five years.</i>
<b><a href="#">hearing</a></b>	The act of hearing attentively. <i>They condemned him without a <b>hearing</b>.</i>

<b>hit</b>	Hit with a missile from a weapon. <i>He <b>hit</b> her hard in the face.</i>
<b><u>intercept</u></b>	An act or instance of intercepting something. <i>A second prism can be swung in to <b>intercept</b> the light beam.</i>
<b>jingle</b>	A comic verse of irregular measure. <i>The <b>jingle</b> of a bridle.</i>
<b>knock</b>	The sound of knocking as on a door or in an engine or bearing. <i>She <b>knocked</b> her knee painfully on the table.</i>
<b><u>lightning</u></b>	A flash or discharge of lightning. <i>A <b>lightning</b> cure for his hangover.</i>
<b><u>onomatopoeia</u></b>	The use of onomatopoeia for literary effect.
<b>pang</b>	A sudden sharp pain or painful emotion. <i>A <b>pang</b> of conscience.</i>
<b>pat</b>	Pat or squeeze fondly or playfully especially under the chin. <i>He <b>patted</b> him consolingly on the shoulder.</i>
<b>ping</b>	Hit with a pinging noise. <i><b>Ping</b> your machine in the office.</i>
<b>rap</b>	Genre of African American music of the 1980s and 1990s in which rhyming lyrics are chanted to a musical accompaniment several forms of rap have emerged. <i>We could be here all night <b>rapping</b> about spiritualism.</i>
<b><u>rub</u></b>	An act of rubbing. <i>He <b>rubbed</b> a finger round the rim of his mug.</i>
<b><u>slam</u></b>	Dance the slam dance. <i>A stellar 12 months saw her win two <b>slams</b> and two Olympic gold medals and retain the number one ranking.</i>
<b>spoil</b>	The act of spoiling something by causing damage to it. <i>Her <b>spoiling</b> my dress was deliberate.</i>
<b><u>strike</u></b>	Undertake strike action against an employer. <i>Small conifers will <b>strike</b> from cuttings.</i>
<b>touch</b>	An act of touching someone or something. <i>Her <b>touch</b> on his shoulder was hesitant.</i>
<b>wiretap</b>	Tap a telephone or telegraph wire to get information. <i>The government illegally <b>wiretapped</b> the lawyers.</i>
