## Associations of "Tapped" (30 Words)

<b>bang</b>	Leap jerk bang. <i>She <b>banged</b> into some shelves in the darkness.</i>
<b>botch</b>	Make a mess of, destroy or ruin. <i>He was accused of <b>botching</b> the job.</i>
<a href="#">bungle</a>	Make a mess of, destroy or ruin. <i>It emerged that forensic police had <b>bungled</b> in gathering the evidence.</i>
<a href="#">caress</a>	A gentle affectionate stroking (or something resembling it). <i>He <b>caressed</b> her face.</i>
<b>crackle</b>	Having the surface decorated with a network of fine cracks as in crackleware. <i>The blazing sun <b>crackled</b> the desert sand.</i>
<b>dab</b>	Press against (something) lightly several times with a piece of absorbent material in order to clean or dry it or to apply a substance. <i>She licked a <b>dab</b> of chocolate from her finger.</i>
<b>ding</b>	Go ding dong like a bell. <i>Cash registers were <b>dinging</b> softly.</i>
<a href="#">door</a>	A room that is entered via a door. <i>He slammed the <b>door</b> as he left.</i>
<b>encouraged</b>	Inspired with confidence.
<b>friction</b>	Conflict or animosity caused by a clash of wills, temperaments, or opinions. <i>A considerable amount of <b>friction</b> between father and son.</i>
<b>fumble</b>	(in ball games) fail to catch or field (the ball) cleanly. <i>He <b>fumbled</b> towards the door.</i>
<a href="#">hear</a>	Examine or hear evidence or a case by judicial process. <i>The jury had <b>heard</b> all the evidence.</i>
<a href="#">hearing</a>	The act of hearing attentively. <i>The court may stay execution pending a <b>hearing</b>.</i>

<b>hit</b>	Hit the intended target or goal. <i>He came all the way around on Williams <b>hit</b>.</i>
<b><u>intercept</u></b>	An act or instance of intercepting something. <i>The fighter plane was ordered to <b>intercept</b> an aircraft that had entered the country's airspace.</i>
<b>jingle</b>	A short slogan, verse, or tune designed to be easily remembered, especially as used in advertising. <i>He makes up advertising <b>jingles</b>.</i>
<b>knock</b>	Knock against with force or violence. <i>The tornado <b>knocked</b> a tree on to a house.</i>
<b><u>lightning</u></b>	A flash or discharge of lightning. <i>A <b>lightning</b> cure for his hangover.</i>
<b><u>onomatopoeia</u></b>	The use of onomatopoeia for literary effect.
<b>pang</b>	A sharp spasm of pain. <i>The snack bar will keep those hunger <b>pangs</b> at bay.</i>
<b>pat</b>	Pat or squeeze fondly or playfully especially under the chin. <i><b>Pat</b> him on the shoulder.</i>
<b>ping</b>	Hit with a pinging noise. <i>The car <b>pinged</b> when I put in low octane gasoline.</i>
<b>rap</b>	A type of popular music of US black origin in which words are recited rapidly and rhythmically over an instrumental backing. <i>He <b>raps</b> under the name of Mr T.</i>
<b><u>rub</u></b>	Reproduce the design of a sepulchral brass or a stone by rubbing paper laid on it with coloured wax pencil or chalk etc. <i>He will be using coffee in a <b>rub</b> for a rack of lamb.</i>
<b><u>slam</u></b>	Dance the slam dance. <i>The new TV soap was <b>slammed</b> as being cynical and irresponsible.</i>
<b>spoil</b>	The act of spoiling something by causing damage to it. <i>The looters carried their <b>spoils</b> away.</i>
<b><u>strike</u></b>	A pitch that passes through the strike zone. <i>The <b>strike</b> lasted more than a month before it was settled.</i>
<b>touch</b>	An act of touching someone or something. <i>Only sight and <b>touch</b> enable us to locate objects in the space around us.</i>
<b>wiretap</b>	Tap a telephone or telegraph wire to get information. <i>The government illegally <b>wiretapped</b> the lawyers.</i>
