Synonyms of "Tasteful" as an adjective (35 Words)

aesthetic	Aesthetically pleasing. <i>The law applies to both functional and aesthetic objects.</i>
appropriate	Suitable for a particular person or place or condition etc. <i>It seems that an apology is appropriate.</i>
artistic	Satisfying aesthetic standards and sensibilities. <i>Computer programs which produce artistic designs.</i>
attractive	Relating to attraction between physical objects. <i>An attractive opportunity.</i>
beautiful	Highly enjoyable. <i>She spoke in beautiful English.</i>

becoming	Displaying or setting off to best advantage. <i>A becoming new shade of rose.</i>
charming	(of a person or their manner) very polite, friendly, and likeable. <i>A charming little cottage.</i>
chic	Elegantly and stylishly fashionable. <i>Chic elegance.</i>
correct	Socially right or correct. <i>Make sure you have been given the correct information.</i>
cultivated	Prepared for raising crops by plowing or fertilizing. <i>He was a remarkably cultivated and educated man.</i>
cultured	(of tissue cells, bacteria, etc.) grown or propagated in an artificial medium. <i>Cultured tastes.</i>
decorous	According with custom or propriety. <i>The tete a tete was decorous in the extreme.</i>
discriminating	Showing or indicating careful judgment and discernment especially in matters of taste. <i>The discriminating eye of the connoisseur.</i>
elegant	Refined and tasteful in appearance or behavior or style. <i>An elegant comfortable house.</i>
exquisite	Intense or sharp. <i>The most exquisite kind of agony.</i>
fastidious	Very concerned about matters of cleanliness. <i>Fastidious about personal cleanliness.</i>
fit	On the point of or strongly disposed. <i>Felt relaxed and fit after their holiday.</i>
fitting	Being precisely fitting and right. <i>It was fitting that his last innings for Middlesex should bring him his highest first class score.</i>
graceful	Having or showing grace or elegance. <i>She was a tall girl slender and graceful.</i>
handsome	(of a number, sum of money, or margin) substantial. <i>Handsome cookery books.</i>
harmonious	Free from disagreement or dissent. <i>Harmonious music.</i>
in good taste	Holding office.

<u>modest</u>	Free from pomp or affectation. <i>He was a very modest man refusing to take any credit for the enterprise.</i>
pleasing	Pleasant or agreeable to the senses. <i>The pleasing austerity of the surroundings.</i>
<u>polite</u>	Having or showing behaviour that is respectful and considerate of other people. <i>The picture outraged polite society.</i>
<u>pretty</u>	Unexpectedly bad. <i>He led me a pretty dance.</i>
proper	(of a psalm, lesson, prayer, etc.) appointed for a particular day, occasion, or season. <i>He is a proper youth.</i>
<u>refined</u>	Developed or improved so as to be precise or subtle. <i>Refined sugar.</i>
<u>respectable</u>	Characterized by socially or conventionally acceptable morals. <i>A perfectly respectable pair of pyjamas.</i>
restrained	Not showy or obtrusive. <i>His restrained gentlemanly voice.</i>
seemly	Conforming to accepted notions of propriety or good taste; decorous. <i>I felt it was not seemly to observe too closely.</i>
<u>sensitive</u>	Quick to detect or respond to slight changes, signals, or influences. <i>Sensitive skin.</i>
smart	(of clothes) attractively neat and stylish. <i>You look very smart.</i>
<u>stylish</u>	Having elegance or taste or refinement in manners or dress. <i>A stylish batsman.</i>
tactful	Having or showing a sense of what is fitting and considerate in dealing with others. <i>She was tactful enough not to shatter his illusion.</i>

- admiration** Respect and warm approval.
*A small token in **admiration** of your works.*
- adorn** Furnish with power or authority; of kings or emperors.
*Pictures and prints **adorned** his walls.*
- appreciation** Delicate discrimination (especially of aesthetic values).
*A full **appreciation** of the professor's life and work will be published in the Scotsman tomorrow.*
- artistic** Relating to or characteristic of art or artists.
***Artistic** workmanship.*
- benediction** A ceremonial prayer invoking divine protection.
*He eventually wins **benediction**.*
- blessing** Grace said before or after a meal.
*May God continue to give us his **blessing**.*

brushwork	An artist's distinctive technique of applying paint with a brush. <i>Canvases characterized by lively flowing brushwork.</i>
cultivated	Refined and well educated. <i>He was a remarkably cultivated and educated man.</i>
cultured	Marked by refinement in taste and manners. <i>A cultured and intelligent man.</i>
dandy	Relating to or characteristic of a dandy. <i>His floppy handkerchiefs and antique cufflinks gave him the look of a dandy.</i>
debonair	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air. <i>All the men looked debonair and handsome in white tie and tails.</i>
elegance	The quality of being graceful and stylish in appearance or manner. <i>The simplicity and elegance of the solution.</i>
elegant	Graceful and stylish in appearance or manner. <i>Elegant handwriting.</i>
enchantingly	In a bewitching manner.
esthetic	Aesthetically pleasing. <i>He despised the esthetic of minimalism.</i>
foppish	Concerned with one's clothes and appearance in an affected and excessive way (typically used of a man). <i>He is foppish and vain.</i>
gentility	Social superiority as demonstrated by polite and respectable manners, behaviour, or appearances. <i>Her grandmother's pretensions to gentility.</i>
glorify	Praise glorify or honor. <i>You are glorifying a rather mediocre building.</i>
grace	In Greek mythology three beautiful goddesses Aglaia Thalia and Euphrosyne believed to personify and bestow charm grace and beauty. <i>A beautiful figure which she used in subtle movements of unparalleled grace.</i>
graceful	Characterized by beauty of movement, style, form, or execution. <i>She was a tall girl slender and graceful.</i>
gracefulness	Beautiful carriage.
gracious	Characterized by charm, good taste, and generosity of spirit. <i>Thanks to the gracious gods.</i>
grateful	Affording comfort or pleasure. <i>The grateful shade.</i>

mincing Affectedly dainty in manner or gait; effeminate (typically used of a man).
*I don't have to go through the rest of my life with that **mincing** voice of yours.*

noble Especially in former times a person of noble rank or birth.
*The medieval palace was once owned by a **noble** Florentine family.*

nobleman A titled peer of the realm.

refined Freed from impurities by processing- Shakespeare.
*She was delicate and **refined** and unused to hardship.*

royal Invested with royal power as symbolized by a crown.
*The **royal** carriage of a stag's head.*

sophisticated Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated.
***Sophisticated** young socialites.*

svelte Showing a high degree of refinement and the assurance that comes from wide social experience.
*She was **svelte** and sophisticated.*
