cheap	Embarrassingly stingy. <i>A cheap restaurant.</i>
cheap and nasty	Of very poor quality; flimsy.
crass	Showing no intelligence or sensitivity. <i>The crass assumptions that men make about women.</i>
crude	Belonging to an early stage of technical development characterized by simplicity and often crudeness. <i>The crude mortality rate.</i>
flavourless	(of food or drink) lacking flavour; bland or tasteless. <i>The soup was thin and flavourless.</i>
garish	Tastelessly showy. <i>Garish colors.</i>
gaudy	Marked by conspicuous display. <i>Silver bows and gaudy ribbons.</i>
gross	Without qualification; used informally as (often pejorative) intensifiers. <i>A gross exaggeration.</i>
inappropriate	Not suitable for a particular occasion etc. <i>Noise seems inappropriate at a time of sadness.</i>
indelicate	Slightly indecent. <i>Forgive me asking an indelicate question but how are you off for money.</i>
indiscreet	Having, showing, or proceeding from too great a readiness to reveal things that should remain private or secret. <i>They have been embarrassed by indiscreet friends.</i>
inelegant	Having or showing a lack of physical grace, elegance, or refinement. <i>An inelegant title.</i>
insipid	Lacking taste or flavor or tang. <i>An insipid personality.</i>
loud	Used chiefly as a direction or description in music loud with force. <i>Her voice was too loud.</i>
low	Low or inferior in station or quality. <i>He smashed a pane low down in the window.</i>
meretricious	Like or relating to a prostitute. <i>Meretricious praise.</i>
offensive	Morally offensive. <i>He is also accused of possessing an offensive weapon.</i>

ostentatious	Tawdry or vulgar. <i>An ostentatious sable coat.</i>
savourless	Lacking taste or flavor or tang.
showy	Superficially attractive and stylish; suggesting wealth or expense. <i>She wore a great deal of showy costume jewellery.</i>
tactless	Revealing lack of perceptiveness or judgment or finesse. <i>A tactless remark.</i>
thin	Relatively thin in consistency or low in density not viscous. <i>A thin plot.</i>
unacceptable	Used of persons or their behavior. <i>Unacceptable behaviour.</i>
unappetizing	Not inviting or attractive; unwholesome. <i>An unappetizing leg of chicken.</i>
uncouth	(of art or language) lacking sophistication or delicacy. <i>An uncouth soldier a real tough guy.</i>
undiplomatic	Not skilled in dealing with others. <i>His arrogant and undiplomatic manner.</i>
unflavoured	Without flavoring added. <i>Unflavoured yogurt.</i>
uninspired	Deficient in originality or creativity; lacking powers of invention. <i>Uninspired writing.</i>
vapid	Lacking significance or liveliness or spirit or zest. <i>A bunch of vapid schoolgirls.</i>
watery	Thin or tasteless as a result of containing too much water. <i>A watery fluid.</i>
weak	Relating to or denoting the weakest of the known kinds of force between particles which acts only at distances less than about 10 cm is very much weaker than the electromagnetic and the strong interactions and conserves neither strangeness parity nor isospin. <i>A weak pulse.</i>
