affiliation	The act of becoming formally connected or joined. A valuable financial affiliation .
aggregation	Several things grouped together or considered as a whole. A single dose of aspirin irreversibly inhibits the normal aggregation of platelets.
alliance	A formal agreement establishing an association or alliance between nations or other groups to achieve a particular aim. <i>The shifting alliances within a large family.</i>
<u>ally</u>	A state formally cooperating with another for a military or other purpose. <i>He s a good ally in fight.</i>
amateur	Someone who pursues a study or sport as a pastime. It takes five years for a top amateur to become a real Tour de France rider.
assemblage	A machine or object made of pieces fitted together. Some vast assemblage of gears and cogs.
association	A social or business relationship. His association of his father with being beaten was too strong to break.
cliquish	(of a group or place) tending to form or hold exclusive groups and so not welcoming to outsiders. A notoriously cliquish political club.
<u>club</u>	The premises used by a particular club. <i>The club scene.</i>
collaboration	Something produced in collaboration with someone. His recent opera was a collaboration with Lessing.
combination	A sequence of numbers or letters that opens a combination lock. <i>This colour combination is stunningly effective.</i>



committee	In the UK a committee appointed by Parliament to consider the details of proposed legislation. <i>There was much scrutiny in committee.</i>
confederacy	A league or alliance, especially of confederate states. The Italian confederacy known as the Lombard League.
<u>confederation</u>	The act of forming an alliance or confederation. A referendum on confederation .
cooperation	The practice of cooperating. They worked in close cooperation with the British Tourist Authority.
football	Any of various forms of team game involving kicking and in some cases also handling a ball in particular in the UK soccer or in the US American football. <i>Wherever the president travels a military aide stays close with the</i> football .
foursome	Four people considered as a unit. Wales led 3 2 after the morning foursome s.
fraternity	A social club for male undergraduates. <i>Members of the hunting fraternity.</i>
group	Form a group or group together. I ve always been a fan of the guitarists in the group .
<u>guild</u>	A medieval association of craftsmen or merchants, often having considerable power.
<u>league</u>	The contest for the championship of a league. <i>The league championship</i> .
membership	The state of being a member. They polled their membership .
<u>player</u>	A person who plays a musical instrument. He was a major player in setting up the corporation.
quartet	A composition for a quartet. <i>He joined a barbershop quartet.</i>
<u>reunion</u>	A party of former associates who have come together again. She had a tearful reunion with her parents.
rugby	A form of football played with an oval ball.
sextet	A composition for a sextet. The sextet from The Marriage of Figaro.
<u>squad</u>	A small squad of policemen trained to deal with a particular kind of crime. <i>An assassination</i> squad .
