individuation	Discriminating the individual from the generic group or species.
isolated	Single; exceptional. An <b>isolated</b> pawn.
<u>isolation</u>	A defense mechanism in which memory of an unacceptable act or impulse is separated from the emotion originally associated with it. <i>He opposed a policy of American</i> <b>isolation</b> .
