Infinitive	<b>to tear</b>
Present Tense	<b>tear / tears</b>
Past Tense	<b>teared</b>
Present Participle	<b>tearing</b>
Past Participle	<b>teared</b>

## Conjugate Tear

### Tear in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>tear</b>	We <b>tear</b>
You <b>tear</b>	You <b>tear</b>
He/She/It <b>tears</b>	They <b>tear</b>

### **Tear in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am tearing</b>	We <b>are tearing</b>
You <b>are tearing</b>	You <b>are tearing</b>
He/She/It <b>is tearing</b>	They <b>are tearing</b>

### **Tear in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have teared</b>	We <b>have teared</b>
You <b>have teared</b>	You <b>have teared</b>
He/She/It <b>has teared</b>	They <b>have teared</b>

### **Tear in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been tearing</b>	We <b>have been tearing</b>
You <b>have been tearing</b>	You <b>have been tearing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been tearing</b>	They <b>have been tearing</b>

### **Tear in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>teared</b>	We <b>teared</b>
You <b>teared</b>	You <b>teared</b>
He/She/It <b>teared</b>	They <b>teared</b>

### **Tear in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

<b>I was tearing</b>	<b>We were tearing</b>
<b>You were tearing</b>	<b>You were tearing</b>
<b>He/She/It was tearing</b>	<b>They were tearing</b>

**Tear in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had teared</b>	<b>We had teared</b>
<b>You had teared</b>	<b>You had teared</b>
<b>He/She/It had teared</b>	<b>They had teared</b>

**Tear in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had been tearing</b>	<b>We had been tearing</b>
<b>You had been tearing</b>	<b>You had been tearing</b>
<b>He/She/It had been tearing</b>	<b>They had been tearing</b>

**Tear in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will tear</b>	<b>We will tear</b>
<b>You will tear</b>	<b>You will tear</b>
<b>He/She/It will tear</b>	<b>They will tear</b>

**Tear in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will be tearing</b>	<b>We will be tearing</b>
<b>You will be tearing</b>	<b>You will be tearing</b>
<b>He/She/It will be tearing</b>	<b>They will be tearing</b>

**Plural**

**I will have teared**

**We will have teared**

**You will have teared**

**You will have teared**

**He/She/It will have teared**

**They will have teared**

**Tear in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been tearing**

**We will have been tearing**

**You will have been tearing**

**You will have been tearing**

**He/She/It will have been tearing**

**They will have been tearing**
