youth Early maturity; the state of being young or immature or inexperienced.
*During the **youth** of the project.*

adolescence The time period between the beginning of puberty and adulthood.
*During **adolescence** teenagers often experience violent mood swings.*

adolescent Relating to or peculiar to or suggestive of an adolescent.
***Adolescent** insecurity.*

adult Behave in a way characteristic of a responsible adult especially by accomplishing mundane but necessary tasks.
*An **adult** woman.*

childhood The state or period of being a child.
*He spent his **childhood** in Lewes.*

cub	Hunt fox cubs. <i>She was as protective as a tiger with her cubs.</i>
delinquency	A tendency to be negligent and uncaring. <i>He inherited his delinquency from his father.</i>
girl	A girl or young woman with whom a man is romantically involved. <i>I look forward to having a night with the girls.</i>
grow	Cultivate by growing often involving improvements by means of agricultural techniques. <i>The tree trunks had grown together.</i>
immature	In an early period of life or development or growth. <i>Many of the fish caught are immature.</i>
infancy	The earliest state of immaturity. <i>A son who died in infancy.</i>
junior	A child attending a junior school. <i>First year juniors.</i>
juvenile	An actor playing a juvenile role. <i>The light coloured plumage of a juvenile.</i>
kid	Leather made from a young goat's skin. <i>She collected the kids from school.</i>
lad	A young man who is boisterously macho. <i>Tony was a bit of a lad always had an eye for the women.</i>
maidenhood	The fact or condition of being a young, unmarried woman. <i>Most brides wear white to symbolize maidenhood.</i>
maturation	The process of an individual organism growing organically; a purely biological unfolding of events involved in an organism changing gradually from a simple to a more complex level. <i>Pod maturation.</i>
nubile	(of a young woman) sexually mature; old enough for marriage. <i>He employed a procession of nubile young secretaries.</i>
playmate	Used euphemistically to refer to a person's lover. <i>Sometimes Valerie wished she had more playmates.</i>
precocious	(of a child) having developed certain abilities or inclinations at an earlier age than is usual or expected. <i>A precocious achievement.</i>
puberty	The period during which adolescents reach sexual maturity and become capable of reproduction. <i>A particularly traumatic puberty.</i>

rebellious	Resisting control or authority. <i>The rebellious republics.</i>
reformatory	An institution to which young offenders are sent as an alternative to prison. <i>Reformatory punishment.</i>
schoolgirl	Characteristic of or associated with schoolgirls. <i>Schoolgirl French.</i>
stripling	A young man. <i>He s a mere stripling.</i>
teen	A teenager. <i>A teen idol.</i>
teenage	Relating to or characteristic of teenagers. <i>A teenage girl.</i>
young	Young people collectively. <i>The young are amazingly resilient.</i>
youngster	A young person of either sex. <i>Tiddler is a British term for youngster.</i>
youth	An early stage in the development of something. <i>This publishing sector is no longer in its youth.</i>
