bending	The act of bending something.
<u>corner</u>	Solid exterior angle of a building especially one formed by a cornerstone. In many <b>corner</b> s of the world they still practice slavery.
<u>disposed</u>	Usually followed by to naturally disposed toward. <i>He is favourably <b>disposed</b> towards the proposals.</i>
emphasis	Special importance or significance. <i>He spoke with <b>emphasis</b> and with complete conviction.</i>
emphasize	Lay stress on (a word or phrase) when speaking. They <b>emphasize</b> the need for daily one to one contact between parent and child.
<u>emphatically</u>	Without doubt; clearly. Greg is <b>emphatically</b> not a slacker.
gangling	Tall and thin and having long slender limbs. A <b>gangling</b> youth with a trace of down on his cheeks.
highlight	Apply a highlighter to one s cheeks or eyebrows in order to make them more prominent. <i>Highlight</i> the area above your eyebrows.



incline	Have a tendency or disposition to do or be something be inclined. <i>He</i> <b>incline</b> <i>d</i> his ear to the wise old man.
inclined	Having made preparations. <i>Inclined</i> to be moody.
<u>lean</u>	Cause to lean or incline. We can <b>lean</b> on this man.
likely	Likely but not certain to be or become true or real. <i>Rain is <b>likely</b>.</i>
<u>prone</u>	Lying flat, especially face downwards. I was lying <b>prone</b> on a foam mattress.
propensity	A natural inclination. Their innate <b>propensity</b> to attack one another.
recumbent	(especially of a person or effigy) lying down. <b>Recumbent</b> shrubs.
<u>slant</u>	Heel over. A new <b>slant</b> on science.
<u>spotlight</u>	Illuminate with a spotlight. The dancers are <b>spotlight</b> ed from time to time throughout the evening.
staircase	A way of access (upward and downward) consisting of a set of steps. A mirrored <b>staircase</b> .
stress	The degree of stress measured in units of force per unit area. In French the last syllable is usually <b>stress</b> ed.
<u>susceptible</u>	Easily impressed emotionally. <i>Susceptible</i> to colds.
<u>talent</u>	Natural abilities or qualities. A mighty steed bought from a Thessalian merchant for thirteen <b>talent</b> s.
tilt	Charge with a tilt. A <b>tilt</b> at the European Cup.
<u>underline</u>	Draw a line under (a word or phrase) to give emphasis or indicate special type. <i>Certain phrases had been underline</i> d.
<u>underscore</u>	(on a computer or typewriter keyboard) a short horizontal line _ on the baseline. The company <b>underscore</b> d the progress made with fuel cells.
yaw	Be wide open. The jet <b>yaw</b> ed sharply to the right.
