## Tenfold as an Adjective

### Definitions of "Tenfold" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “tenfold” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Containing ten or ten parts.*
- *Ten times as great or as numerous.*
- *Having ten parts or elements.*

### Synonyms of "Tenfold" as an adjective (2 Words)

**denary** Numbered or proceeding by tens; based on ten.  
***Denary** numbers.*

**ten-fold** Containing ten or ten parts.

- *A tenfold increase in the use of insecticides.*

<b>augment</b>	Make (something) greater by adding to it; increase. <i>He <b>augmented</b> his summer income by painting houses.</i>
<b>denominator</b>	The divisor of a fraction.
<b>doubly</b>	To double the degree. <i>He was <b>doubly</b> wrong.</i>
<b>eight</b>	One of four playing cards in a deck with eight pips on the face.
<b>eleven</b>	Being one more than ten.
<b>exponential</b>	Of or involving exponents. <i>The social security budget was rising at an <b>exponential</b> rate.</i>
<b>fifteen</b>	Being one more than fourteen.
<b>fifty</b>	A United States bill worth 50 dollars.
<b>five</b>	A playing card or a domino or a die whose upward face shows five pips.
<b>forty</b>	Being ten more than thirty.
<b>hundred</b>	A subdivision of a county or shire, having its own court. <i>Wantage <b>Hundred</b>.</i>
<b>increase</b>	The amount by which something increases. <i>The <b>increase</b> is scheduled for next month.</i>
<b>millennium</b>	The prophesied thousand-year reign of Christ at the end of the age (Rev. 20:1-5). <i>The people must seize power the <b>millennium</b> cannot be imposed on them from above.</i>
<b>multiply</b>	Have young (animals) or reproduce (organisms). <i>Researchers <b>multiply</b> these varieties to provide new plants for the farmers.</i>
<b>nine</b>	One of four playing cards in a deck with nine pips on the face.
<b>nineteen</b>	Being one more than eighteen.
<b>numerate</b>	Read out loud as words written numbers. <i>Teachers should ensure that their pupils are literate and <b>numerate</b>.</i>
<b>seven</b>	One of four playing cards in a deck with seven pips on the face.
<b>seventeen</b>	Being one more than sixteen.
<b>seventy</b>	The cardinal number that is the product of ten and seven.
<b>six</b>	Denoting a quantity consisting of six items or units.
<b>sixteen</b>	Being one more than fifteen.
<b>sixty</b>	The cardinal number that is the product of ten and six.
<b>ten</b>	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
<b>thirteen</b>	Being one more than twelve.

<b>thirty</b>	Being ten more than twenty.
<b>thousand</b>	Denoting a quantity consisting of 1,000 items or units.
<b><u>times</u></b>	An arithmetic operation that is the inverse of division; the product of two numbers is computed. <i>You <b>times</b> the six by four to get twenty four.</i>
<b>twelve</b>	Denoting a quantity consisting of 12 items or units.
<b>twenty</b>	A United States bill worth 20 dollars.
