ten-fold Containing ten or ten parts.

augment	Make (something) greater by adding to it; increase. <i>He augmented his summer income by painting houses.</i>
denominator	The divisor of a fraction.
doubly	To double the degree. <i>He was doubly wrong.</i>
eight	One of four playing cards in a deck with eight pips on the face.
eleven	Being one more than ten.
exponential	Of or involving exponents. <i>The social security budget was rising at an exponential rate.</i>
fifteen	Being one more than fourteen.
fifty	A United States bill worth 50 dollars.
five	A playing card or a domino or a die whose upward face shows five pips.
forty	Being ten more than thirty.
hundred	A subdivision of a county or shire, having its own court. <i>Wantage Hundred.</i>
increase	The amount by which something increases. <i>The increase is scheduled for next month.</i>
millennium	The prophesied thousand-year reign of Christ at the end of the age (Rev. 20:1-5). <i>The people must seize power the millennium cannot be imposed on them from above.</i>
multiply	Have young (animals) or reproduce (organisms). <i>Researchers multiply these varieties to provide new plants for the farmers.</i>
nine	One of four playing cards in a deck with nine pips on the face.
nineteen	Being one more than eighteen.
numerate	Read out loud as words written numbers. <i>Teachers should ensure that their pupils are literate and numerate.</i>
seven	One of four playing cards in a deck with seven pips on the face.
seventeen	Being one more than sixteen.
seventy	The cardinal number that is the product of ten and seven.
six	Denoting a quantity consisting of six items or units.
sixteen	Being one more than fifteen.
sixty	The cardinal number that is the product of ten and six.
ten	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
thirteen	Being one more than twelve.

thirty	Being ten more than twenty.
thousand	Denoting a quantity consisting of 1,000 items or units.
<u>times</u>	An arithmetic operation that is the inverse of division; the product of two numbers is computed. <i>You times the six by four to get twenty four.</i>
twelve	Denoting a quantity consisting of 12 items or units.
twenty	A United States bill worth 20 dollars.
