Infinitive	to tennis
Present Tense	tennis / tennises
Past Tense	tennised
Present Participle	tennising
Past Participle	tennised

# **Conjugate Tennis**

### **Tennis in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>tennis</b>	We <b>tennis</b>
You <b>tennis</b>	You <b>tennis</b>
He/She/It <b>tennises</b>	They <b>tennis</b>

## **Tennis in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am tennising	We are tennising
You <b>are tennising</b>	You <b>are tennising</b>
He/She/It is tennising	They are tennising

#### **Tennis in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have tennised	We have tennised
You have tennised	You have tennised
He/She/It has tennised	They have tennised

### **Tennis in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been tennising	We <b>have been tennising</b>
You <b>have been tennising</b>	You <b>have been tennising</b>
He/She/It has been tennising They have been tennising	

## **Tennis in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>tennised</b>	We <b>tennised</b>
You <b>tennised</b>	You <b>tennised</b>
He/She/It <b>tennised</b>	They <b>tennised</b>

### **Tennis in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was tennising	We were tennising
You <b>were tennising</b>	You were tennising
He/She/It was tennising	They were tennising

#### **Tennis in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had tennised	We had tennised
You <b>had tennised</b>	You had tennised
He/She/It had tennised	They had tennised

#### **Tennis in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been tennising	We had been tennising
You <b>had been tennising</b>	You had been tennising
He/She/It had been tennising	They had been tennising

# **Tennis in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will tennis	We <b>will tennis</b>
You <b>will tennis</b>	You <b>will tennis</b>
He/She/It will tennis	They will tennis

# **Tennis in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be tennising	We will be tennising
You <b>will be tennising</b>	You will be tennising
He/She/It will be tennising	They will be tennising

#### **Tennis in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have tennised	We will have tennised
You <b>will have tennised</b>	You will have tennised
He/She/It will have tennised	They will have tennised

# **Tennis in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been tennising	We <b>will have been tennising</b>
You <b>will have been tennising</b>	You <b>will have been tennising</b>
He/She/It will have been tennising	They will have been tennising
