## Associations of "Terrifying" (30 Words)

<u>afraid</u>	Feeling fear or anxiety; frightened. <i>I am afraid</i> we have witnessed only the first phase of the conflict
<u>alarming</u>	Frightening because of an awareness of danger. <i>Our countryside is disappearing at an <b>alarming</b> rate.</i>
appall	Strike with disgust or revulsion.
<u>chilling</u>	Provoking fear terror. A <b>chilling</b> account of the prisoners fate.
claustrophobia	Extreme or irrational fear of confined places. The small stuffy room had begun to give him <b>claustrophobia</b> .
<u>dread</u>	Causing fear or dread or terror. The band appeals to <b>dread</b> s and baldheads alike.
<u>dreadful</u>	Exceptionally bad or displeasing. There s been a <b>dreadful</b> accident.



fear	Be sorry; used to introduce an unpleasant statement. I <b>fear</b> she might get aggressive.
fearful	Causing or likely to cause people to be afraid; horrifying. <i>Fearful</i> slum conditions.
fearfulness	The trait of being afraid.
fearsome	Causing fear or dread or terror. The cat mewed displaying a <b>fearsome</b> set of teeth.
<u>formidable</u>	Extremely impressive in strength or excellence. The <b>formidable</b> prospect of major surgery.
fright	Frighten. Ghosts could never af <b>fright</b> her.
frighten	Drive out by frightening. At his age I guess he doesn t <b>frighten</b> any more.
<u>frightening</u>	The act of inspiring with fear. A <b>frightening</b> experience.
frightful	Provoking horror- Winston Churchill. A <b>frightful</b> mistake.
hideous	Extremely ugly. The whole <b>hideous</b> story.
<u>horrific</u>	Causing fear or dread or terror. <i>Horrific</i> injuries.
horror	Something that inspires horror something horrible. Many have a <b>horror</b> of consulting a dictionary.
<u>macabre</u>	Shockingly repellent; inspiring horror. A <b>macabre</b> series of murders.
<u>panic</u>	Cause sudden fear in or fill with sudden panic. The crowd <b>panic</b> ked and stampeded for the exit.
petrify	Change into stone. Slogans <b>petrify</b> our thinking.
<u>scare</u>	Become scared. Recent food <b>scare</b> s have made the public rightly sensitive to new apparently untested technologies.
scared	Fearful; frightened. I was <b>scared</b> that people were going to take pictures of me.
scary	Uncannily striking or surprising. A <b>scary</b> movie.



<u>spooky</u>	Sinister or ghostly in a way that causes fear and unease. Some horses are more <b>spooky</b> by nature than others.
terrible	Extremely unpleasant or disagreeable. <i>The weather was <b>terrible</b>.</i>
terrify	Cause to feel extreme fear. She was terrified he would drop her.
terror	Terrorism. Weapons of <b>terror</b> .
<u>worry</u>	Be concerned with. I began to <b>worry</b> whether I had done the right thing.
