admiration	Pleasurable contemplation. A small token in admiration of your works.
appreciate	Understand (a situation) fully; grasp the full implications of. The Germans want to appreciate the Deutsche Mark.
appreciated	Fully understood or grasped. Dangers not yet appreciated .
appreciation	Increase in monetary value. <i>He expressed his appreciation in a short note.</i>
appreciative	Feeling or showing gratitude or pleasure. The team are very appreciative of your support.
<u>beholden</u>	Owing thanks or having a duty to someone in return for help or a service. I don t like to be beholden to anybody.
beneficence	The quality of being kind or helpful or generous.
<u>beneficiary</u>	A person who derives advantage from something, especially a trust, will, or life insurance policy.
debtor	A person who owes a creditor; someone who has the obligation of paying a debt. Generally debtor s must negotiate with each creditor separately.
delighted	Filled with wonder and delight. We were delighted to see her.
donate	Give to a charity or good cause. She donate s to her favorite charity every month.
endowment	A form of life insurance involving payment of a fixed sum to the insured person on a specified date, or to their estate should they die before this date. University endowments .



feel	Grope or feel in search of something. I made the students feel different about themselves.
<u>generosity</u>	The quality of being kind and generous. I was overwhelmed by the generosity of friends and neighbours.
generously	In a way that shows a readiness to give more of something, especially money, than is necessary or expected. <i>Food is shared generously.</i>
gift	Give as a present make a gift of. <i>His mother s gift of a pen.</i>
giver	Someone who devotes himself completely. There are no greater giver s than those who give themselves.
grateful	Feeling or showing an appreciation for something done or received. <i>Grateful</i> for the tree s shade.
gratitude	The quality of being thankful; readiness to show appreciation for and to return kindness. <i>He was overwhelmed with gratitude for their help.</i>
<u>indebted</u>	Owing gratitude or recognition to another for help or favors etc. I am indebted to her for her help in indexing my book.
largess	Liberality in bestowing gifts; extremely liberal and generous of spirit.
magnanimity	The fact or condition of being magnanimous; generosity. Both sides will have to show magnanimity .
<u>obligated</u>	Caused by law or conscience to follow a certain course. Was obligated to pay off the student loan.
<u>pleased</u>	Experiencing or manifesting pleasure. Both girls were pleased with their new hairstyles.
relieved	Made easier to bear. Relieved parents who had waited anxiously for news.
<u>tasteful</u>	Having or showing or conforming to good taste. A tasteful lounge bar.
<u>thankful</u>	Expressing gratitude and relief. I was very thankful to be alive.
thanks	An expression of gratitude. Thanks to hard work it was a great success.
<u>tolerant</u>	Tolerant and forgiving under provocation. Fault tolerant computer systems.
