admiration	Pleasurable contemplation. <i>A small token in admiration of your works.</i>
appreciate	Understand (a situation) fully; grasp the full implications of. <i>The Germans want to appreciate the Deutsche Mark.</i>
appreciated	Fully understood or grasped. <i>Dangers not yet appreciated.</i>
appreciation	Increase in monetary value. <i>He expressed his appreciation in a short note.</i>
appreciative	Feeling or showing gratitude or pleasure. <i>The team are very appreciative of your support.</i>
beholden	Owing thanks or having a duty to someone in return for help or a service. <i>I don't like to be beholden to anybody.</i>
beneficence	The quality of being kind or helpful or generous.
beneficiary	A person who derives advantage from something, especially a trust, will, or life insurance policy.
debtor	A person who owes a creditor; someone who has the obligation of paying a debt. <i>Generally debtors must negotiate with each creditor separately.</i>
delighted	Filled with wonder and delight. <i>We were delighted to see her.</i>
donate	Give to a charity or good cause. <i>She donates to her favorite charity every month.</i>
endowment	A form of life insurance involving payment of a fixed sum to the insured person on a specified date, or to their estate should they die before this date. <i>University endowments.</i>

feel	Grope or feel in search of something. <i>I made the students feel different about themselves.</i>
<u>generosity</u>	The quality of being kind and generous. <i>I was overwhelmed by the generosity of friends and neighbours.</i>
generously	In a way that shows a readiness to give more of something, especially money, than is necessary or expected. <i>Food is shared generously.</i>
gift	Give as a present make a gift of. <i>His mother s gift of a pen.</i>
giver	Someone who devotes himself completely. <i>There are no greater givers than those who give themselves.</i>
grateful	Feeling or showing an appreciation for something done or received. <i>Grateful for the tree s shade.</i>
gratitude	The quality of being thankful; readiness to show appreciation for and to return kindness. <i>He was overwhelmed with gratitude for their help.</i>
<u>indebted</u>	Owing gratitude or recognition to another for help or favors etc. <i>I am indebted to her for her help in indexing my book.</i>
largess	Liberality in bestowing gifts; extremely liberal and generous of spirit.
magnanimity	The fact or condition of being magnanimous; generosity. <i>Both sides will have to show magnanimity.</i>
<u>obligated</u>	Caused by law or conscience to follow a certain course. <i>Was obligated to pay off the student loan.</i>
<u>pleased</u>	Experiencing or manifesting pleasure. <i>Both girls were pleased with their new hairstyles.</i>
relieved	Made easier to bear. <i>Relieved parents who had waited anxiously for news.</i>
<u>tasteful</u>	Having or showing or conforming to good taste. <i>A tasteful lounge bar.</i>
<u>thankful</u>	Expressing gratitude and relief. <i>I was very thankful to be alive.</i>
thanks	An expression of gratitude. <i>Thanks to hard work it was a great success.</i>
<u>tolerant</u>	Tolerant and forgiving under provocation. <i>Fault tolerant computer systems.</i>
