## Associations of "Thanks to" (30 Words)

<b><a href="#">admiration</a></b>	Something regarded as impressive or worthy of respect. <i>They were lost in <b>admiration</b> of the scenery.</i>
<b>appreciate</b>	Rise in value or price. <i>The dollar <b>appreciated</b> against the euro by 15 per cent.</i>
<b>appreciated</b>	Fully understood or grasped. <i>Dangers not yet <b>appreciated</b>.</i>
<b>appreciation</b>	Delicate discrimination (especially of aesthetic values). <i>I smiled in <b>appreciation</b>.</i>
<b>appreciative</b>	Having or showing appreciation or a favorable critical judgment or opinion. <i>Was <b>appreciative</b> of his efforts.</i>
<b><a href="#">beholden</a></b>	Owing thanks or having a duty to someone in return for help or a service. <i>I don't like to be <b>beholden</b> to anybody.</i>
<b>beneficence</b>	The quality of being kind or helpful or generous.
<b>debtor</b>	A person, country, or organization that owes money. <i><b>Debtor</b> countries.</i>
<b>delighted</b>	Greatly pleased. <i>We were <b>delighted</b> to see her.</i>
<b>donate</b>	Provide or contribute (electrons or protons). <i>A portion of the proceeds will be <b>donated</b> to charity.</i>
<b>endowment</b>	The act of endowing with a permanent source of income. <i>An <b>endowment</b> policy.</i>
<b>feel</b>	Feelings of heightened emotion. <i>I made the students <b>feel</b> different about themselves.</i>
<b><a href="#">generosity</a></b>	Acting generously. <i>I was overwhelmed by the <b>generosity</b> of friends and neighbours.</i>
<b>generously</b>	Enough or more than enough in size or amount; plentifully. <i>Everyone is asked to give <b>generously</b> to this worthy cause.</i>

<b>gift</b>	Present someone with a gift or gifts. <i>He has a <b>gift</b> for comedy.</i>
<b>giver</b>	Person who makes a gift of property. <i>A <b>giver</b> of advice.</i>
<b>grateful</b>	Feeling or showing an appreciation for something done or received. <i>She gave him a <b>grateful</b> smile.</i>
<b>gratitude</b>	A feeling of thankfulness and appreciation. <i>He was overwhelmed with <b>gratitude</b> for their help.</i>
<b><u>indebted</u></b>	Owing gratitude or recognition to another for help or favors etc. <i>I am <b>indebted</b> to her for her help in indexing my book.</i>
<b>largess</b>	A gift or money given (as for service or out of benevolence); usually given ostentatiously.
<b><u>obligated</u></b>	Caused by law or conscience to follow a certain course. <i>Felt <b>obligated</b> to repay the kindness.</i>
<b><u>pleased</u></b>	Proud of one's achievements, especially excessively so; self-satisfied. <i>A <b>pleased</b> smile.</i>
<b><u>priceless</u></b>	Very amusing. <i>Darling you re <b>priceless</b>.</i>
<b>relieved</b>	No longer feeling distressed or anxious; reassured. <i><b>Relieved</b> parents who had waited anxiously for news.</i>
<b><u>tasteful</u></b>	Free from what is tawdry or unbecoming. <i>A <b>tasteful</b> lounge bar.</i>
<b>thank</b>	Express gratitude to (someone), especially by saying "Thank you." <i>Mac <b>thanked</b> her for the meal and left.</i>
<b><u>thankful</u></b>	Pleased and relieved. <i>I was very <b>thankful</b> to be alive.</i>
<b>treasure</b>	A collection of precious things. <i>The island is <b>treasured</b> by walkers and conservationists.</i>
<b>valuable</b>	Having great material or monetary value especially for use or exchange. <i>My time is <b>valuable</b>.</i>
