Associations of "Theocracy" (30 Words)

authoritarian	An authoritarian person. <i>The timid child of authoritarian parents.</i>
autocracy	A political system governed by a single individual. <i>The Grand Duchy of Tuscany was an autocracy.</i>
bureaucratic	Over-concerned with procedure at the expense of efficiency or common sense. <i>The scheme is overly bureaucratic and complex.</i>
despot	A cruel and oppressive dictator.
despotic	Belonging to or having the characteristics of a despot. <i>His administration was arrogant and despotic.</i>
despotism	A form of government in which the ruler is an absolute dictator (not restricted by a constitution or laws or opposition etc. <i>Some nations are democracies others are despotisms.</i>
devout	Deeply religious. <i>She was a devout Catholic.</i>
dictator	(in ancient Rome) a chief magistrate with absolute power, appointed in an emergency. <i>My boss is a dictator who makes everyone work overtime.</i>
dictatorship	Government by a dictator. <i>The effects of forty years of dictatorship.</i>
dominate	Be in control. <i>A picturesque city dominated by the cathedral tower.</i>
fascism	(in general use) extreme authoritarian, oppressive, or intolerant views or practices. <i>This is yet another example of health fascism in action.</i>
fascist	A person who is extremely right-wing or authoritarian. <i>Eastern European fascists could win power only with support from the Nazis.</i>

feudal	Of or relating to or characteristic of feudalism. <i>The feudal system.</i>
<u>government</u>	The study of government of states and other political units. <i>Rules for the government of the infirmary.</i>
illiberal	Narrow-minded about cherished opinions. <i>Illiberal and anti democratic policies.</i>
monocracy	A system of government by one person only.
<u>monopolize</u>	Have and control fully and exclusively. <i>They instituted press censorship and monopolized the means of communication.</i>
oligarchy	A country governed by an oligarchy. <i>The ruling oligarchy of military men around the president.</i>
<u>oppression</u>	The state of being subject to oppressive treatment. <i>A region shattered by oppression and killing.</i>
persecution	Persistent annoyance or harassment. <i>His persecution at the hands of other students.</i>
plutocracy	Government by the wealthy. <i>No one can accept public policies which turn a democracy into a plutocracy.</i>
political	Relating to the ideas or strategies of a particular party or group in politics. <i>Political pressure.</i>
proletarian	A member of the proletariat. <i>They are true proletarians.</i>
<u>regime</u>	A coordinated programme for the promotion or restoration of health a regimen. <i>Ideological opponents of the regime.</i>
religious	A member of a religious order who is bound by vows of poverty and chastity and obedience. <i>She has strong religious convictions.</i>
<u>reverent</u>	Showing great reverence for god. <i>A reverent silence.</i>
ruling	Currently exercising authority or influence. <i>The ruling was reversed in the appeal court.</i>
totalitarianism	A form of government in which the ruler is an absolute dictator (not restricted by a constitution or laws or opposition etc). <i>Democratic countries were fighting against totalitarianism.</i>

A state under cruel and oppressive government.

tyrant

A tyrant flycatcher.

*The **tyrant** was deposed by popular demonstrations.*
