Synonyms of "Thicket" as a noun (9 Words)

A device for slowing or stopping a moving vehicle, typically by applying

brake pressure to the wheels.

Constrained resources will act as a **brake** on research.

brush The act of brushing your teeth.

He gave the seat a **brush**.

brushwood Undergrowth, twigs, and small branches.

They built a fire of **brushwood**.

clump A grouping of a number of similar things.

A **clump** of ferns.



An area of woodland in which the trees or shrubs are periodically cut back to

coppice ground level to stimulate growth and provide firewood or timber.

Much **coppice** is no longer managed as such.

copse A small group of trees.

covert A flock of coots.

It is a good omen when a **covert** of coots have taken to any particular locality.

Garden consisting of a small cultivated wood without undergrowth.

grove An olive grove.

A twisted and tangled mass that is highly interwoven.

A tangle of government regulations.
