Definitions of "Thicket" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “thicket” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A dense group of bushes or trees.*
- *A dense growth of bushes.*



Synonyms of "Thicket" as a noun (9 Words)

- brake** A device for slowing or stopping a moving vehicle, typically by applying pressure to the wheels.
*Constrained resources will act as a **brake** on research.*
- brush** The act of brushing your teeth.
*He gave the seat a **brush**.*
- brushwood** Undergrowth, twigs, and small branches.
*They built a fire of **brushwood**.*
- clump** A grouping of a number of similar things.
*A **clump** of ferns.*

coppice	An area of woodland in which the trees or shrubs are periodically cut back to ground level to stimulate growth and provide firewood or timber. <i>Much coppice is no longer managed as such.</i>
<u>copse</u>	A small group of trees.
<u>covert</u>	A flock of coots. <i>It is a good omen when a covert of coots have taken to any particular locality.</i>
grove	Garden consisting of a small cultivated wood without undergrowth. <i>An olive grove.</i>
<u>tangle</u>	A twisted and tangled mass that is highly interwoven. <i>A tangle of government regulations.</i>



Usage Examples of "Thicket" as a noun

- *A horned owl perfectly camouflaged in a dense thicket.*
