## Associations of "Thought out" (30 Words)

<a href="#">artistic</a>	Satisfying aesthetic standards and sensibilities. <i>A denial of <b>artistic</b> freedom.</i>
<b>brainstorming</b>	A group problem-solving technique in which members spontaneously share ideas and solutions. <i><b>Brainstorming</b> can generate some wonderful ideas.</i>
<b>commonsensical</b>	Exhibiting native good judgment. <i>Unlearned and <b>commonsensical</b> countryfolk were capable of solving problems that beset the more sophisticated.</i>
<a href="#">conceivable</a>	Capable of being imagined or grasped mentally. <i>In every <b>conceivable</b> way that action was entirely wrong.</i>
<a href="#">conceive</a>	Have the idea for. <i>A brilliantly <b>conceived</b> and executed robbery.</i>
<b>conceptualize</b>	Have the idea for. <i>Sex was <b>conceptualized</b> as an overpowering force in the individual.</i>
<b>creative</b>	A person whose job involves creative work. <i>The most important people in the mix will be <b>creatives</b> and direct marketing specialists.</i>
<b>creativity</b>	The ability to create. <i>Firms are keen to encourage <b>creativity</b>.</i>
<b>defeatist</b>	A person who expects or is excessively ready to accept failure. <i>We have a duty not to be so <b>defeatist</b>.</i>
<b>exclude</b>	Prevent from entering; keep out. <i>The unruly student was <b>excluded</b> from the game.</i>
<b>extrapolation</b>	The action of estimating or concluding something by assuming that existing trends will continue or a current method will remain applicable. <i>Caution is advised in the interpretation and <b>extrapolation</b> of results.</i>
<b>genius</b>	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>Boucher s paintings did not suit the austere <b>genius</b> of neoclassicism.</i>

<b><u>groundbreaking</u></b>	The ceremonial breaking of the ground to formally begin a construction project. <i><b>Groundbreaking</b> research into fertility problems.</i>
<b>idea</b>	A mental impression. <i>He has an <b>idea</b> that we don't like him.</i>
<b><u>imagery</u></b>	Visually descriptive or figurative language, especially in a literary work. <i>Tennyson uses <b>imagery</b> to create a lyrical emotion.</i>
<b>imaginable</b>	Capable of being imagined. <i>The most spectacular views <b>imaginable</b>.</i>
<b><u>imaginative</u></b>	Marked by independence and creativity in thought or action- Lewis Mumford. <i>He was <b>imaginative</b> beyond all other architects.</i>
<b>innovative</b>	(of a product, idea, etc.) featuring new methods; advanced and original. <i>Stylistically <b>innovative</b> works.</i>
<b><u>inventive</u></b>	Having the ability to create or design new things or to think originally. <i>Had an <b>inventive</b> turn of mind.</i>
<b>judiciousness</b>	The trait of forming opinions by distinguishing and evaluating.
<b><u>mentality</u></b>	Mental ability. <i>Machines can possess <b>mentality</b>.</i>
<b>minded</b>	Interested in or enthusiastic about a particular thing. <i>Career <b>minded</b>.</i>
<b>notion</b>	(usually plural) small personal articles or clothing or sewing items. <i>Children have different <b>notions</b> about the roles of their parents.</i>
<b>objectively</b>	In a way that is not dependent on the mind for existence; actually. <i>The researchers are <b>objectively</b> assessing risk factors.</i>
<b>philosophical</b>	Characterized by the attitude of a philosopher; meeting trouble with level-headed detachment. <i><b>Philosophical</b> writing.</i>
<b><u>reasoning</u></b>	Endowed with the capacity to reason. <i>He explained the <b>reasoning</b> behind his decision at a media conference.</i>
<b><u>resourceful</u></b>	Having inner resources; adroit or imaginative. <i>You will become stronger and more <b>resourceful</b> in the face of adversity.</i>
<b>sagacity</b>	The mental ability to understand and discriminate between relations. <i>A man of great political <b>sagacity</b>.</i>
<b>think</b>	An act of thinking. <i>I <b>think</b> that he is her boyfriend.</i>
